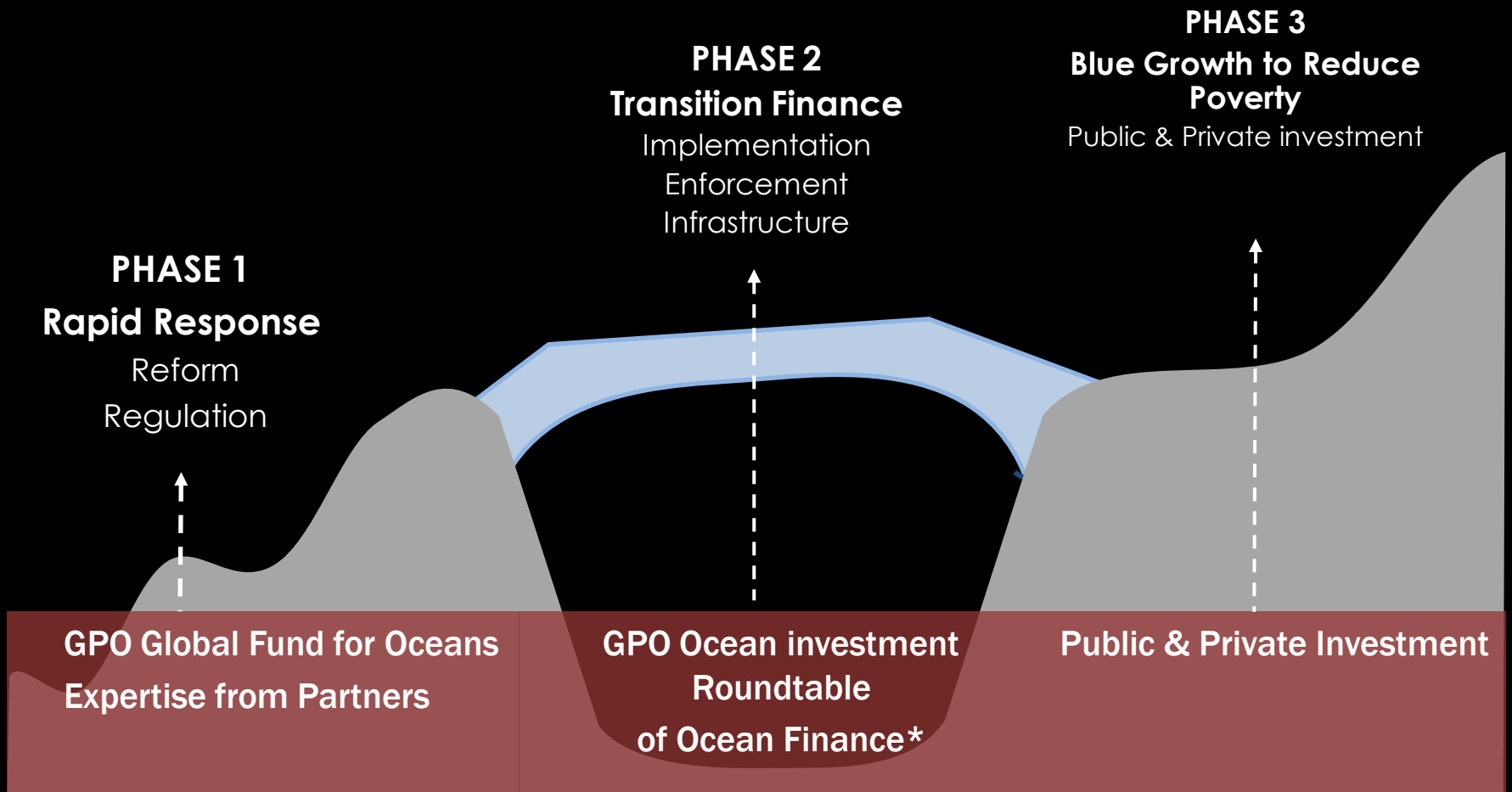
Recovering Ocean health is a global challenge that demands global collaboration
