Proposed Budget

What Makes UNEA3 Budget Exceptionally Low

- ✓ Duration → (i) 3 days open ended Committee of Permanent Representatives (CPR), (ii) 2 weekend days of Major Group and Stakeholders, and (iii) 3 days of UNEA back to back meetings.
- ✓ No Programme of Work (PoW) and Budget deliberations and approvals
- ✓ Limited number of resolutions (approx. 6 compared to 25)

Budget Assumptions:

- ✓ Participants (*priority for LDCs*) → 48 LDCs, 32 DCs and 50 representatives of Major Groups & Stakeholders.
- ✓ DSA Payments → 10 days DSA calculated for participants

- ✓ UNEA3 budget is intended to be funded 30% by the Environment Fund and 70% by extra budgetary funds
- As of today, Extra Budgetary Resources are at \$875,593 of the planned budget; leaving us with a deficit of \$524,407.
