STATUS OF PAINTS AT NATIONAL AND REGIONAL LEVELS

□ National levels

- ✓ No existing laws or regulations that limit (regulate) the lead content in paints sold or imported in CI;
- ✓ Nevertheless, Elaboration in 2015 of a framework law on chemicals management which draft text has been approved by all technical ministries and relevant stakeholders. The problems caused by lead paint pollution are taken into account in this law.

✓ Volontary action:

15 years ago, all paint manufacturers used lead ingredients. From 2003 to date, some manufacturers have voluntarily stopped using lead additives for the formulation of their paint. Especially, two manufacturers no longer use lead compounds (TISA and IPL-PPG)



STATUS OF PAINTS AT NATIONAL AND REGIONAL LEVELS

☐ Regional levels

ECOWAS standards on paint on elaboration process are still in statu-quo since Cote d'Ivoire is asking for lead-free paints standards at regional level.
