DECISION 1/20 – Transmission of information

The Conference:

Recalling Article 13 of the Bamako Convention on the Ban of the Import into Africa and the Control of Transboundary Movement and Management of Hazardous Wastes within Africa¹;

Recognizing that the fulfillment of obligations under Article 13 of the Convention might constitute a burden for most of the Parties

Hereby:

1. **Endorses** on an interim basis the Transmission of Information Form annexed hereto (Annex I);
2. **Requests** the Parties to provide reports in accordance with Article 13 for the calendar year 2014 using this Form as endorsed by this meeting;
3. **Instructs** the Legal and Technical Working Group (LTWG) to revise and amend the Form for consideration at the next Conference of the Parties;
4. **Requests** the Secretariat to prepare country-fact sheets after Parties have fulfilled their first reporting requirements and subsequent ones under the Bamako Convention and to make such information available on a regular basis to the Parties, Non Parties, any other related Convention Secretariats, institutions and agencies having a direct interest in the environmentally sound management of hazardous wastes.
5. **Further requests** the Secretariat to provide Parties with advice for the management of information on hazardous wastes;
6. **Encourages** the Secretariat to seek and identify the necessary funding to assist Parties upon request to set up procedures and other arrangements to facilitate the collection of their data and the preparation of inventories of hazardous wastes;
7. **Encourages** the Parties that are in a position to do so to collaborate with and assist the Parties in need in setting up procedures and other arrangements to facilitate the collection of data and preparation of inventories of hazardous wastes;
8. **Further requests** the Secretariat to establish a clearinghouse mechanism and link it to other relevant clearinghouses or databases managed by regional organizations or members, and also with other relevant Secretariats of Conventions.
9. **Encourages** the Secretariat to identify necessary funds to hold a training workshop on Reporting and Inventories of Hazardous Wastes for focal points, competent authorities and Dump watches.

¹ **Art. 13** establishes procedures for transmission of information among Parties and between the Parties and the Secretariat.

INTRODUCTION

The Parties to the Bamako Convention are required, in accordance with Articles 13 of the Convention, to inform each other, through the Secretariat of the Bamako Convention, on issues related to the implementation of the Convention. To facilitate reporting by Parties, the Conference of the Parties has adopted the Form on “Transmission of Information”. The Form consists of two parts, namely, Part I: Status of information; and Part II: Annual reporting.

All Parties should complete Part I: Status of Information of the questionnaire for a certain calendar year which might need to be updated for any subsequent year.

Part I: Status of Information covers issues such as designation of Competent Authority, Focal Point and Dumpwatch; national definitions of waste; national definitions of hazardous waste; restrictions on transboundary movements of hazardous wastes, radioactive wastes and other wastes; control procedure of the transboundary movements of waste; reduction and/or elimination of the generation of hazardous wastes and other wastes; reduction of the amount of hazardous wastes and other wastes subject to transboundary movements; effect on human health and the environment; bilateral, multilateral or regional agreements or arrangements; disposal and recovery facilities and sources of technical and financial assistance.

Part II: Annual reporting covers those issues for which reporting are required on an annual basis. For the ease of electronic reporting and processing of the reported data/information, Part II: Annual reporting is divided into two sections namely, Section A and Section B.

Part II: Section A covers issues such as export/import hazardous wastes and other wastes and generation of hazardous wastes and other wastes.

Part II: Section B covers issues such as disposals, which did not proceed as intended and accidents occurring during the transboundary movement and disposal of hazardous wastes, radioactive wastes and other wastes.

Some of the general guidelines to fill in the questionnaire are:

- Complete the questionnaire in English.
- Ensure that all quantities are in metric tons.
- Complete the questionnaire by providing information/data in the required format.
- Provide an electronic version of the completed questionnaire, if possible, or use a typewriter or else handwritten in block letters for legibility.

The manual could be referred for more information, which is available in all six United Nations languages (Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish).
