








Percent of Countries with Lead Paint Laws in Each UN Environment Region






















Number of Countries in the Africa Region with Lead Paint Laws




















Number of Countries in the Asia and the Pacific Region with Lead Paint Laws




















Number of Countries in the West Asia Region with Lead Paint Laws



















Number of Countries in the North America Region with Lead Paint Laws





















Number of Countries in the Europe Region with Lead Paint Laws






















Number of Countries in the Latin America and the Caribbean Region with Lead Paint Laws
