A regulation on lead in paints is among the regulations to be implemented in the 2009 E.C (2016/2017) fiscal year

The regulation will be under pollution control proclamation

# Updates cont'd

Lead paint regulation Working group discussed on:

1. Concentration limit

Weather to use <90ppm or <600ppm: justification for this was given for PAN-Ethiopia and Tadesse Amera (Director of PAN-Ethiopia) took the assignment

2. Objectives of the regulation

to be drafted; PAN-Ethiopia took the assignment

#### 3. Who and How to regulate

- Who should be regulated?
- Liability clauses: Licence renewal should be based on meeting the regulation requirements
- Licence renewal will not be given for those who violated the regulation

### 4. Monitoring bodies

Who will be monitoring paint manufacturers whether they follow the regulations or not?

## 5. Labelling

Should labelling be mandatory or voluntary?

#### 6. Grace period

How long should the grace period be: How many months until manufacturers finish their stock?
