Law on chemicals

- Restrictions and prohibitions of certain chemicals - Article 34
- Rulebook on amendments of rulebook on restriction of the use, distribution and production of chemicals that present an unacceptable risk to human health and the environment (Official Gazette of Montenegro, No. 12/16)

Rulebook on amendments of rulebook on restriction of the use, distribution and production of chemicals that present an unacceptable risk to human health and the environment

- Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), establishing a European Chemicals Agency
- Commission Regulation (EU) No 836/2012 of 18 September 2012 amending Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) as regards lead;
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/628 of 22 April 2015 amending Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals ('REACH') as regards lead and its compounds.

Carbonates and sulphates of lead

- It is forbidden to trade in and use of these substances or mixtures containing them when they are intended for use in paints.
- The prohibitions do not apply to the use of these substances or mixtures containing these substances for the restoration and maintenance of works of art, historic buildings and their interiors.

Lead and its compounds

- Placing on the market and use of the individual parts of the product price if the concentration of lead (expressed as metal) in such a part is equal to or greater than 0.05% by weight.

Lead – emission to air and waste management

- Law on waste management - collecting, recycling and disposition of product and waste which contain Pb – Decree on taking over, collection and processing of spent batteries and accumulators;
- Law on air quality – reduce emission of lead, reducing the content of lead in fuel – Decree in fuel quality, decree on emission from stationary sources.
