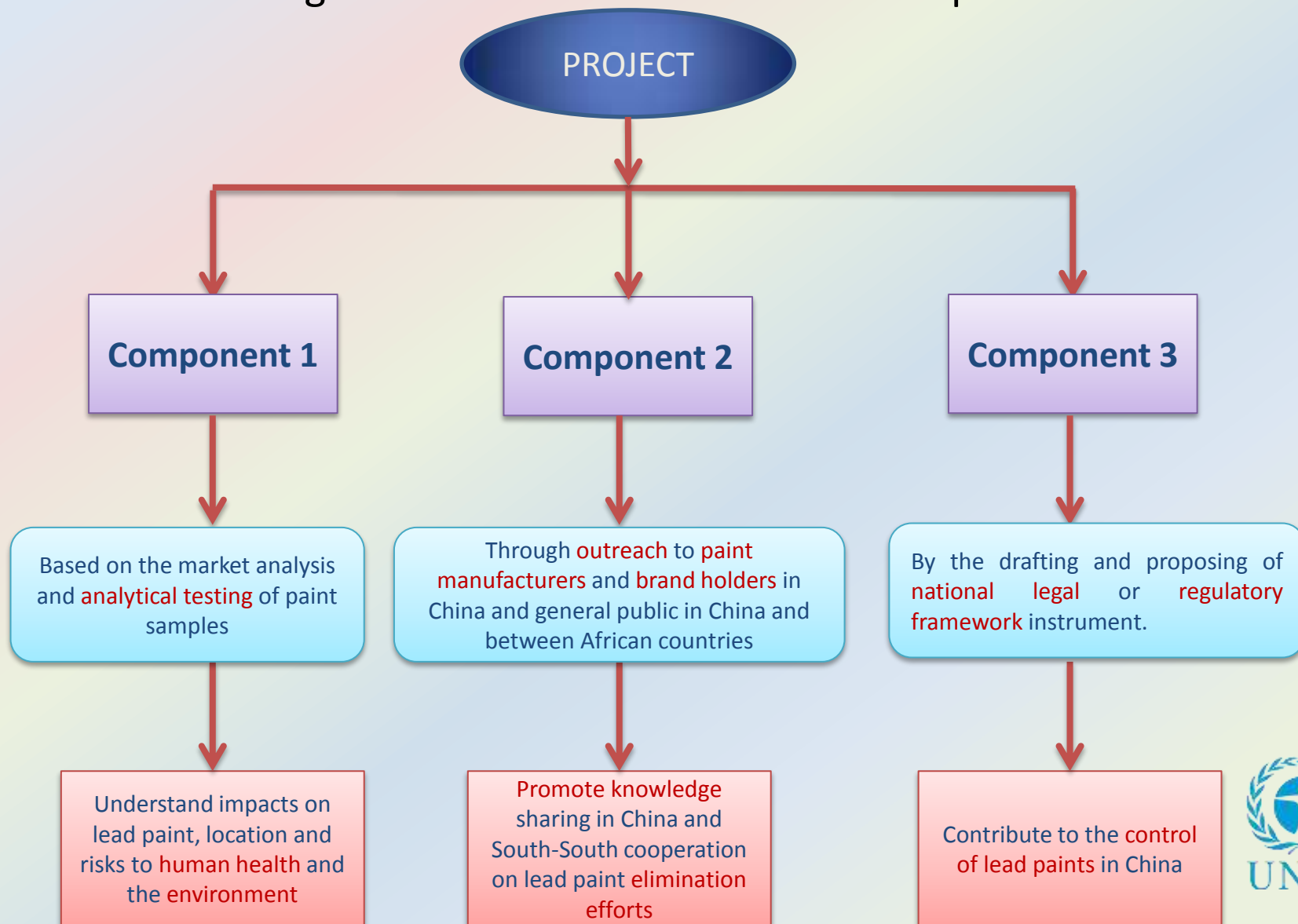

Key components of this project

The project promotes the elimination of the use of lead paints in China and Africa through its three below-mentioned components.



Component 2

Planned activities

Organise a “south-south cooperation” coordination workshop between African countries & China

Develop detailed national lead paint awareness raising strategies in China

Consultation with appropriate government agencies on the testing data results

Develop and disseminate awareness raising materials on lead to stakeholders

Organize activities to civil society, paint industry and national paint manufacturers

Expected Outcome

Improved knowledge of the risk posed by lead in paint leads to the development of sound reductions strategies for lead in paint and brand holders ceasing to add lead to paint in China.

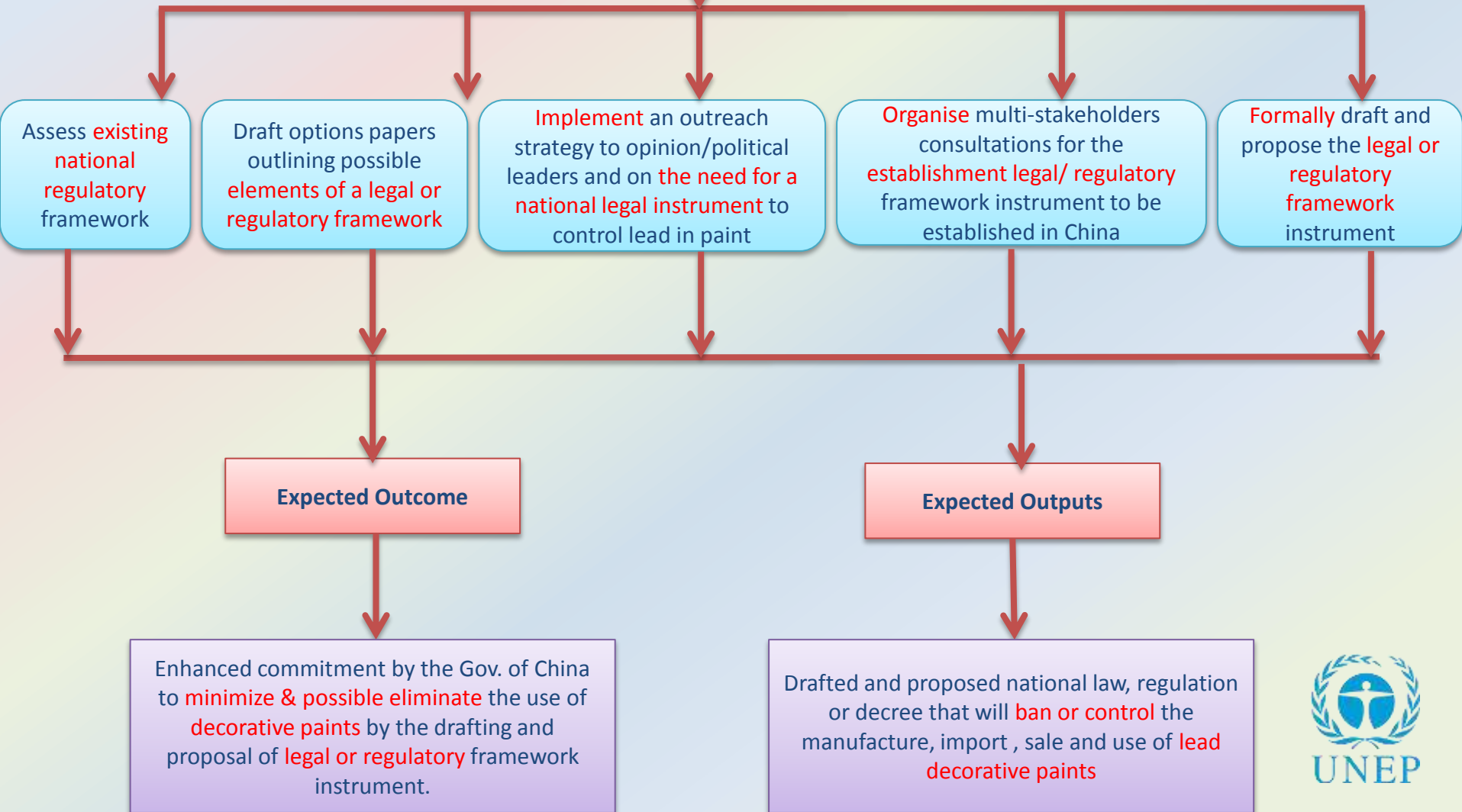
Expected Outputs
