



Budget for 2018 (based on 2018-2019 biennium)




Income (Funds Received) January - June 2018




Available Resources (Funds Available) January - June 2018




Expenditure January - June 2018




Budget, Income, Available Resources and Expenditure (Annual Funds) January - June 2018




Budget, Income, Available Resources and Expenditure (Multi-Year Funds) January - June 2018

BALANCING THE FUNDING



Core funding must be strengthened. It is needed to

- Support Global policy making (Governing Bodies)
- Coordinate environmental programmes in the UN system
- Identify emerging environmental issues
- Innovate solutions
- Advocate and raise awareness
- Build capacity and transfer technology
- Ensure results-based planning and management and robust oversight

Regular Budget is not expected to substantially increase – focus is therefore on the Environment Fund.
