Please accept this request to join the UNEP Global Mercury Partnership on behalf of Concorde East/West Sprl, which has worked worldwide on mercury issues for more than 25 years. This letter confirms support of the Partnership; commits to work toward its goal of protecting human health and the global environment from the release of mercury and its compounds by minimizing and, where feasible, ultimately eliminating global, anthropogenic mercury releases to air, water and land; and specifies below how CE/W will contribute to meeting the goal of the Partnership in each of the following partnership areas:

- mercury cell chlor-alkali production. CE/W will continue to share information on this industry, including quantities of mercury used and released, remediation of decommissioned sites and waste treatment, etc.
- mercury in products. CE/W will continue to develop and share information on regional and global use of mercury in products (with a particular focus on dental amalgam), and will support efforts to reduce these uses.
- mercury waste management. CE/W will continue to develop and share information on the management of mercury wastes, especially in the oil and gas industry.
- mercury supply and storage. CE/W will continue to develop and share information on sources and trade of mercury worldwide, and especially mercury supply as a critical indicator of the effectiveness of the Minamata Convention.
