### Why?

- Rio+20 outcome document
- UNEP GC Decision 27/2
- Inform the discussion on the establishment of new mechanisms for stakeholder engagement

### What?

- Compilation of practices from selected organisations
- Descriptive document
- No comparative analysis of the practices
- Verified

















#### How?

- Review of practices on:
  - Participation in decision-making bodies;
  - Rules and procedures;
  - Accreditation;
  - MG/civil society approach used; and
  - Access-to-information, information disclosure.
- 17 organisations listed based on:
  - Most cited practices;
  - Known to be progressive;
  - Accessible information; and
  - Relevance to sustainable development.















# **Findings**

- Formal practices
  - Participation in an organized manner through observer status
  - Representative civil society bodies
  - Participation of major groups and stakeholders in governing bodies and their subsidiary organs
  - Adoption and implementation of safeguard policies
- Non-formal practices
  - Consultative bodies without decision-making powers
  - Work with Major Groups and Stakeholders through 'organizing partners'

  - ILO tripartite body
  - ICCM/SAICM intergovernmental process
- Rules and procedures
  - CSD (baseline)
  - UN-REDD
- Accreditation
  - UNCCD

  - World Bank
  - UNDP
- Aarhus convention and Aarhus principles
