Chilika Health Report Card by June Likely

Bhubaneswar: The first issue of the Eco-system Health Report Card for Chilika, a first of its kind monitoring mechanism, is expected to be ready by June.

A team of scientists from Maryland University as well as India are working on the report card. The team is currently finalising the methodology for the study basing on which information will be generated and devised over the next two months.

"We are expecting the report to be ready in next four months. Chilika's health will be studied on three indices - fisheries, water quality and biodiversity," said Dr Heath Kesley of Integration and Application Network (IAN) of Maryland University.

Chilika is the first ecosystem

to have adopted this system in India. The scientists who also met Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik to apprise him about the progress of the project will assess data generated by Chilika Development Authority over the last 14 years and basing on it, will formulate new data and prepare indices.

The system could actually be a catalyst for other eco-system management. National Project Director of Integrated Coastal Zone Management Project Vivek Wadekar said, the Chilika project will be studied closely and if it turns out to be successful, similar health card systems will be introduced in West Bengal and Gujarat where ICZMP is being implemented on a pilot basis, apart from Odisha.

Wadekar said, National Centre for Sustainable Coastal Management (NCSCM) will be

requested to develop a methodology which is specific to India and is based on international practices. In fact, Gujarat Government is interested that the Chilika Report Card should be replicated in Gulf of Kutch, Dr R Ramesh of NCSCM said.

United National Environment Programme Officer-in-Charge Anjan Datta said the report card will be devised in such a manner that it will be easy to communicate to all segments of stakeholders. It will not just be about numbers but also comprise graphics and colour schemes.

Chief Executive of CDA Ajit Patnaik said, the report card's periodicity will be finalised once the first issue is out. It is likely to be an annual affair and benefit not only lake managers but also policy makers and researchers.
