Six global Regional Seas Strategic Directions (2004-2007)

1. Regional Seas Contribution to Sustainable Development. 2. Political Commitment & financial sustainability. 3. Visibility. 4. Support Knowledge-based policy making, public participation & awareness. 5. RS as a platform for implementation of **Multilateral Environment Agreements (MEAs).** 6. Integrated management based on the ecosystem approach.

Achievements

- High-level participation in the decisionmaking process for the sustainability of the marine envt.

- Regional Seas – facilitated the implementation of global initiatives (MDGs, WSSD/JPOI Targets)

- Unique regional approach to address transboundary issues (GEF financing)

Achievements - cont'd

- Increased global interest in the marine environment.

- Increased partnerships (NGOs, private sector, civil society in general, GEF projects etc.)

- Increased regional cooperation, particularly in the development of legal framework & (forum) facilitate the ratification of MEAs.

Challenges

Diversity of the Regional Seas – different priorities

- Medium & long-term financial sustainability

- Ecosystem approach acknowledged, but different approaches poses different methodological challenges

Challenges cont'd

- Economic value of marine resources

- Data/information availability on the state of the marine environment (fragmented data for comparability) & need for regular reporting

 Institutional challenges (different bodies/commissions – MEAs)
