INFORMATION DOCUMENT

I Introduction

The United Nations Environment Programme would like to welcome you to Nairobi, Kenya for the 14th Global Meeting of the Regional Seas Conventions and Action Plans.

In this information document you will find practical details related to conference venue, transport and hotel reservations.

General Information

Kenya is located on the eastern coast of Africa, right on the equator. It is a land of striking landscapes, ranging from snow-capped Mount Kenya to rich farmlands, barren deserts and tropical beaches. It borders Somalia, Ethiopia and Sudan in the north, Uganda in the west, Tanzania in the south, and the Indian Ocean in the east. Kenya's capital city is Nairobi. Other major cities are Mombasa, the main port on the Indian Ocean and Kisumu on Lake Victoria. The eight provinces of Kenya range in geographical size from the small Nairobi Province to the much larger eastern and Rift Valley provinces. Kenya's national parks are wildlife, marine and botanical sanctuaries set aside to conserve their unique species and for educational and recreational enjoyment by Kenyans and tourists.

II Venue

III Registration and Badges

All participants are requested to register on arrival at the Visitors Pavillion in the UN Complex. Registration will open from Saturday, 29 September 2012 and continued until 12.00 noon on Monday, 1 October 2012.

A list of participants has been submitted to UN Security located at the Visitor's Pavillion, where a ground pass "badge" will be issued for the duration of the meeting.

IV Travel

By air:

Jomo Kenyatta International Airport is approximately 16 kilometres south-west of the centre of Nairobi. The airport is served by airport taxis available at the arrival hall.

The airport host 49 scheduled airlines; JKIA services direct flight connections to Europe, the Middle East, Far East and Africa. It forms the main hub for Kenya Airways, JetLink Express and Fly540.

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VI Passport and Visas

Passports are required for entry to the country

Many foreigners need a visa to enter Kenya. Most countries can receive a visa upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. The visa fee for a single entry is USD 50.

Diplomatic, Official, Service and Courtesy visas are issued Gratis.

Nationals (Passport Holders) of the following countries shall have their visa applications referred to the Director of Immigration Services in Nairobi for approval. The processing varies from case to case. No expedited services for Referred Visa applications.

Afghanistan, Senegal, Azerbaijan, Kosovo, Somalia, Armenia, Lebanon, Syria, Cameroon, Libya, Palestine, Eritrea, Mali, Tajikistan, Iraq, Democratic Peoples Republic of Korea (Formerly North Korea).

VII Health

A yellow fever vaccination certificate is mandatory for travelers over one year of age coming from countries where yellow fever may occur. Angola, Benin, Bolivia, Brazil, Cameroon, Colombia, Ecuador, Democratic Republic of Congo, Gabon, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Liberia, Peru Sierra Leone and Sudan have been indicated as countries where yellow fever may occur, but no guarantees can be given that no certificates are required from other countries. Malaria risk exists throughout the year in Kenya, though there is little risk in Nairobi and the highlands.

VIII Currency

The currency in Kenya is Kenya Schilling (KSH). The exchange rate is approximately 83.8 to the US Dollar.

Local currency can be obtained in the Bureau de Change or a available ATMs at the airport.

Alternatively, a branch of the Kenya Commercial Bank (KCB) is located in the UN complex at the lower lobby. In addition you will find several Forex Exchange around Gigiri area.

IX Power Supply

Power supply is 220/240 volt/60 Hertz. Plugs and sockets use the three-pin type. Please make sure to bring along a power adapter for use in Kenya.

X Time Zone and Climate

Nairobi is known for its cool and highland climate. In October it can rain up to 52 mm, so make sure to bring an umbrella or your waterproofs.

The average temperature in October max 26°C (79°F) min 13°C (55°F)

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
