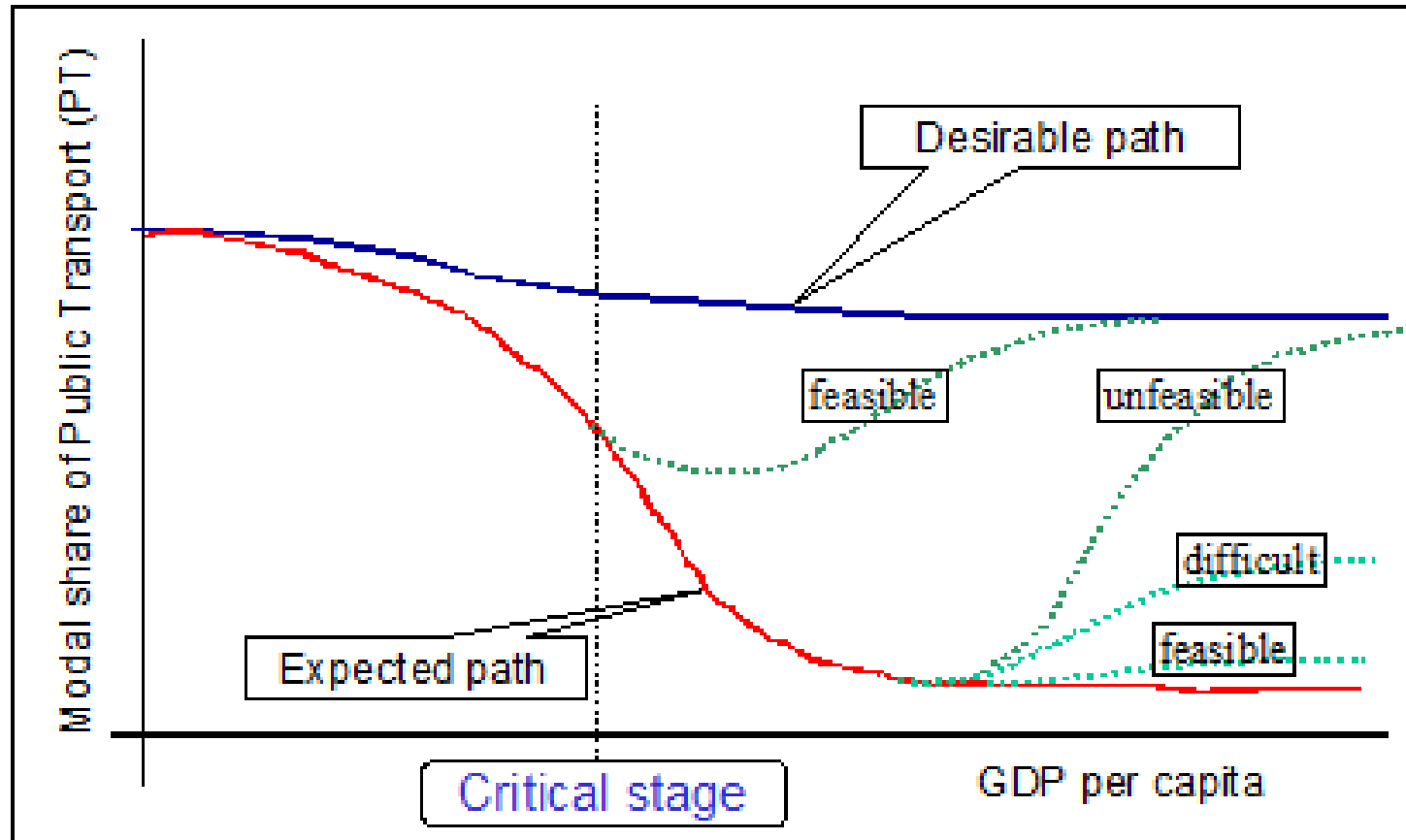

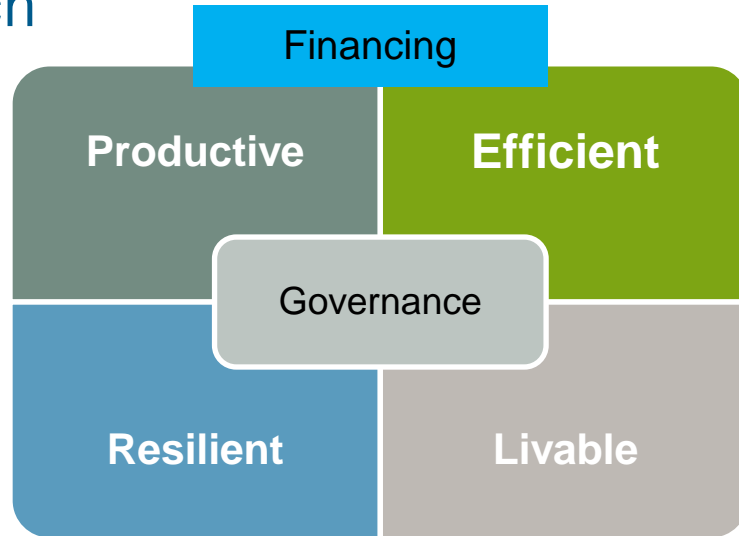

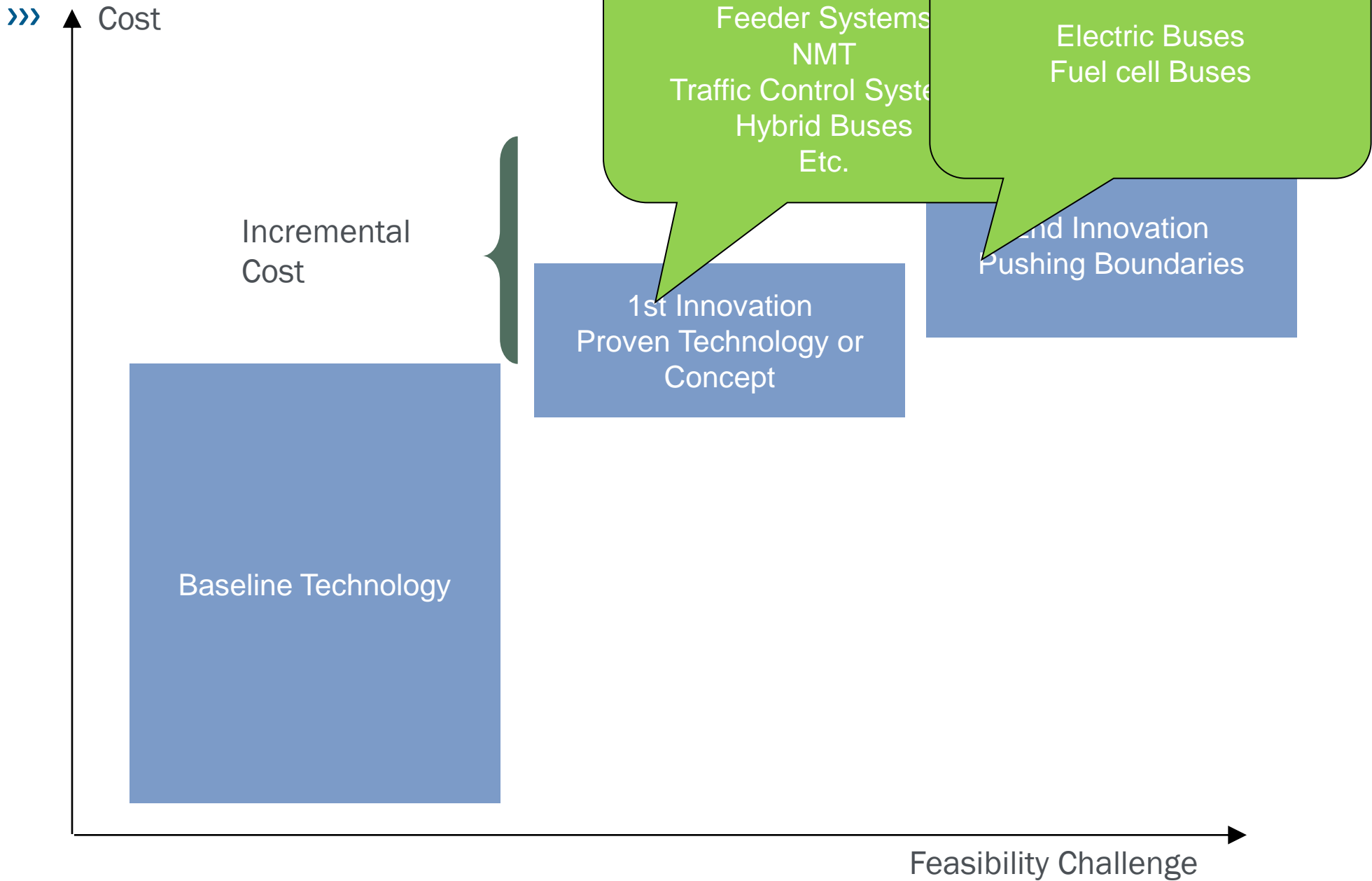

»» Projects Pipeline – Climate Friendly Urban Mobility Projects

- › Integrated public waterways project Kochi: (KMRL and Kerala) – approx. EUR 85 million – aim seamless mobility:
 - › (appraisal in August 2015; DEA/MUD approvals awaited)

- › Integrated BRT Systems aim Multi modal integration
- › **Chennai:**, Transport Dept, - approx. EUR 180 mn;
- › **Coimbatore** (MAWS, TN) - DPR under preparation
- › **Bangalore:** (DULT, Karnataka) - approx. 130 mn Euros
 - › integration of BRT with metro ; pre appraisal of the BRT project in August 2014

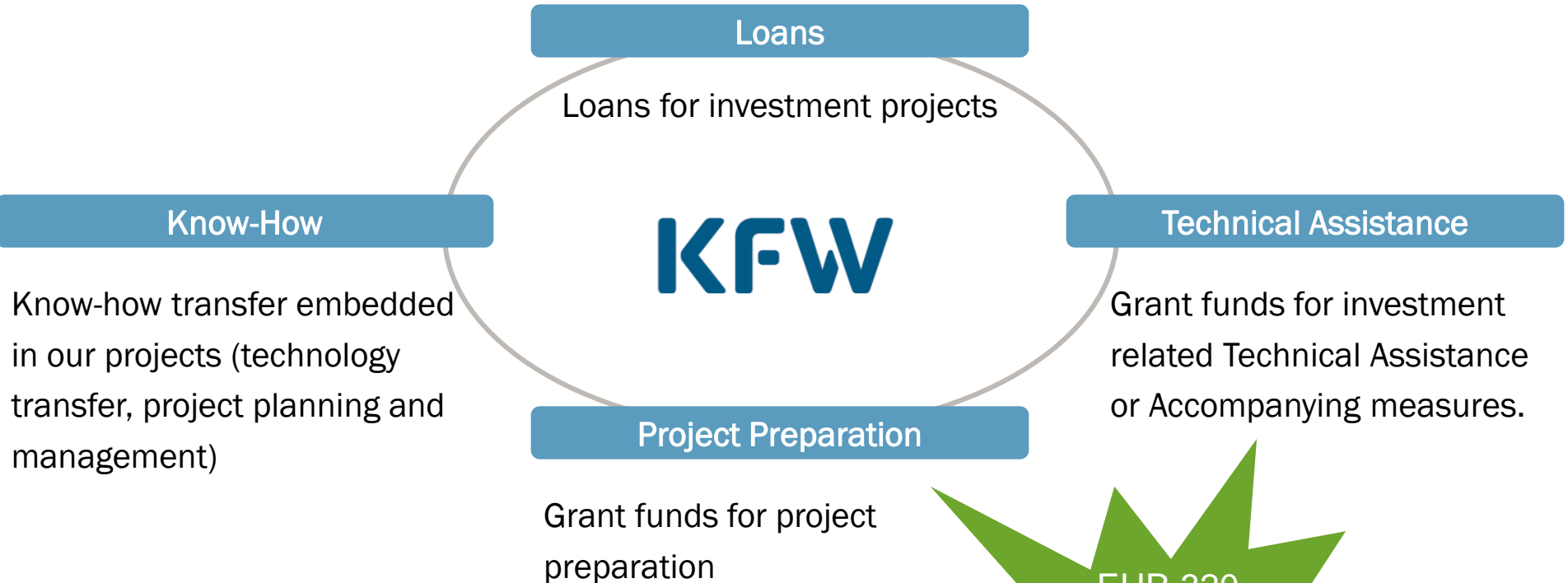
