Since 2016 Batrec Industrie AG also operates a stabilization plant for mercury with a capacity of 1.200 t/year, in which mercury is transformed into HgS and subsequently disposed.

We think that the availability of safe recycling technologies for mercury containing waste and especially of a stabilization technology for mercury is an important part for a successful implementation of the Minamata Convention and in order to minimize mercury releases to the environment.

We would be pleased to participate in the UNEP Global Mercury Partnership meetings to provide our recycling and stabilization technology as well as our experience.
