Institutional arrangements for Stockholm Convention reporting

- Department of Hazardous Substance Management is a national focal point for Stockholm Convention on POPs
- Responsible for Stockholm Convention Reporting
- Responsible for NIP development, update and implementation arrangements
- Lacking of experienced personnel

Information and data collection for Stockholm Convention reporting

- Data sources used: National Implementation Plan
- No data collection systems in place yet
- No QA & QC in place yet
- Challenges:
 - Lacking of data collection mechanism
 - Limited data and information

Use of Stockholm Convention Electronic Reporting System and reporting formats

- Electronic Reporting System and reporting formats are used
- **Challenge:**
 - Access is sometimes difficult
 - Format is complicated

Challenges summary

- Lacking of experienced personals/Officers
- Lacking of data collection mechanism
- Limited data and information to access
- Sometimes is difficult to access and format is complicated
