





#### **Challenges**

- Synergistic Implementation at National Level to promote an integrated approach in SDG implementation
- Integrating the UN Reforms into UNEP Strategic Planning

#### **Opportunities**

- Integrating the UN Reforms into UNEP Strategic Planning e.g. MTS and POW development
- Leveraging of global governance processes: Kigali Amendment, Escazu Agreement, Montevideo V, the post 2020 biodiversity framework, climate finance, Amendment to the Bases Convention

- Align the Support of countries in national legislation / policy development with the new Resident Coordinator's office to ensure coherence in the context of UN Reform.
