As you are aware, the 4th United Nations Environment Assembly decided to create a review process of the Committee of Permanent Representatives (UNEP/EA.4/2, paragraphs 9 to 12). Specifically, it decided that *“it will be co-chaired by two members of the Committee of Permanent Representatives, one from a developing country and one from a developed country”*.
