Mandate UNEA 4/22

- Develop a monitoring mechanism
- Propose options for an improved framework for reporting on the implementation of UNEA resolutions
- Report to the UNEA-5 on implementation of resolution



CPR Engagement

- 146th CPR --Three reporting options proposed
- 6th Annual Subcommittee additional guidance provided
- 148th CPR requested a new consolidated proposal -- selecting best elements of each and to continue to develop the website on monitoring



Consolidated Proposal

- Inter-sessional reporting on resolutions:
 - Quarterly CPR reports to contain information on resolutions
 - Dedicated reports to CPR and Subcommittee as per relevant agenda items
 - Updates through annual and biennial PPR
- Access to online information through the web-based monitoring mechanism, once operationalized









Monitoring & Reporting Mechanism

 - Secretariat and voluntary member state reporting on resolutions










Member States Voluntary Reporting










Roadmap for Monitoring Mechanism
