Plastic pollution is a transboundary issue. No one state or country can achieve it alone in the national level.

It's why a GLOBAL AGREEMENT ON PLASTIC POLLUTION is the way of joint fight against plastic pollution. The new global agreement on plastic pollution which adopts a global approach to tackle the full life cycle of plastics must be the basis of our reflections and the objective of our meetings.

- For the purpose of ensuring effective participation of all stakeholders in online meetings we propose that consideration should be given to:
 - Restrict each meeting to one topic to allow for in-depth discussions.
 - Organize a separate Regional and Major Groups online meetings whose outcomes can feed into the Global Meetings

While the road-map has taken into account the existing situation it is important to note that we may live with the virus for a long time and online meetings will have its limitations. We should start thinking about 'restricted' face-to face meetings. Meetings that comply with WHO/Health regulations.
