## **B. Monitoring & Assessment**

#### (iii) Water Quality Monitoring in the Wider Caribbean Region: New

Budget: USD 85,000 (10,000 from UNDP/GEF CLME+ & 75,000 unfunded)

#### **Activities:**

Completion of SOCAR & sharing on appropriate platform linking to SOMEE & State of Habitat & the Caribbean Marine Atlas

Training on Driver Pressure State Response (DPSR) approach

Communications Strategy: policy briefs, infographics, fact sheets.

Capacity-building support to develop national water quality monitoring programmes

Develop new project concepts to address data and capacity gaps



## C. Waste Management

#### (iv) Caribbean Node for Marine Litter Management

**Budget: USD 120,000 (unfunded)**

#### (vi) Caribbean Platform for Nutrients Management

**Budget: USD 307,900 (UN Human Security Trust Fund)** 

#### **Activities:**

Training on Integrated Water Resources Management & Water Harvesting Systems (IWEco);

Develop & Distribute Knowledge Materials & Products;

Establish & Strengthen reuse/recycling systems (PAHO);

Support policy & institutional reform for pollution reduction (UNDP)

Promote use of waste as a resource (PAHO);



## E. National Programmes of Action

#### (vii) Caribbean Platform for Nutrients Management (ongoing)

Budget: USD 300,000 (UNDP/GEF CLME+)

#### **Activities:**

Finalize regional strategy & action plan on nutrients

Prepare baseline pre-feasibility assessment reports on nutrients

Develop regional investment plans for pollution focussing on nutrients reduction

Implement Ecosystem Based Adaptation (EBA) sub-project for the S. Caribbean & N. Brazil

Support coordinated work to assess the impacts of Nutrients on the Sargassum invasion & develop/disseminate appropriate responses/best practices

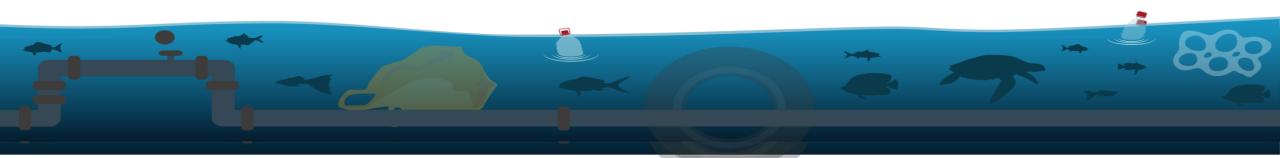

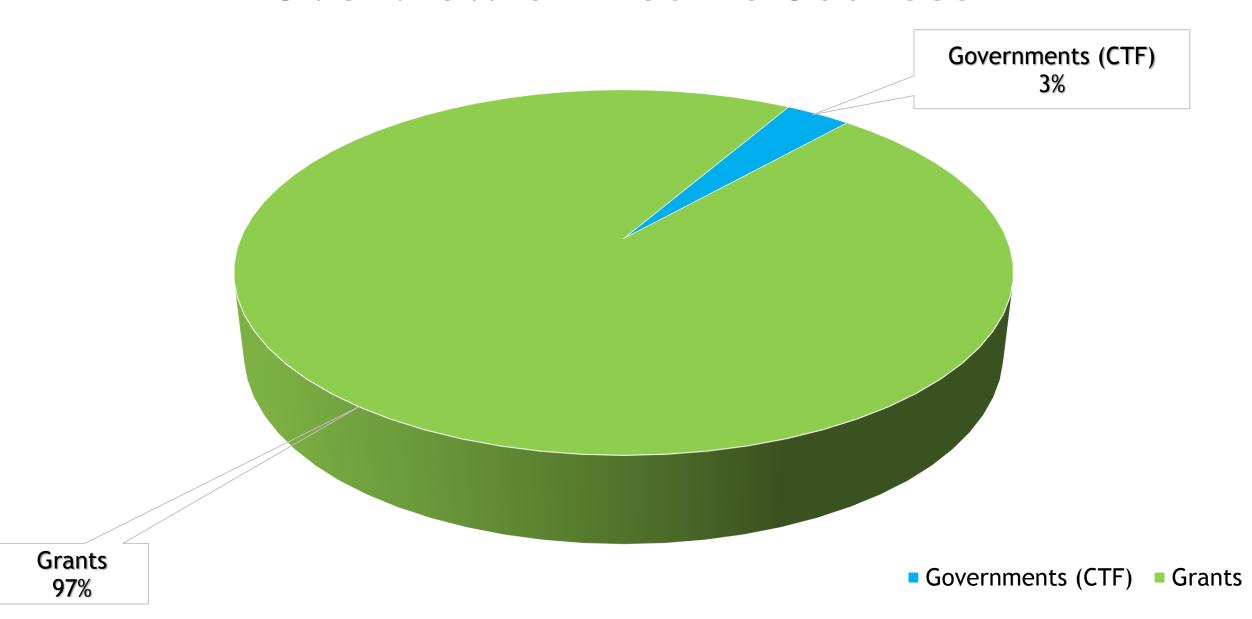

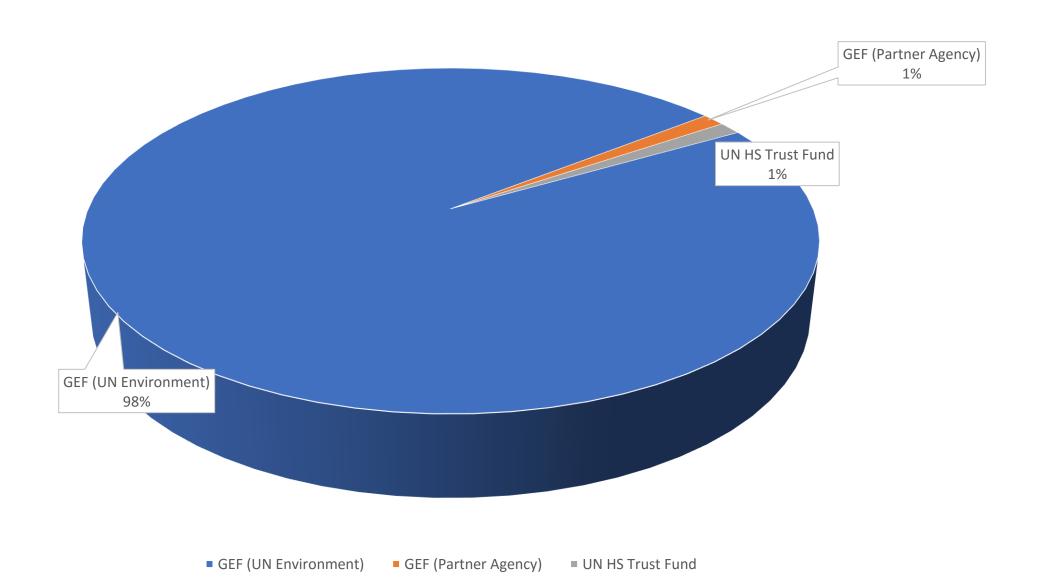

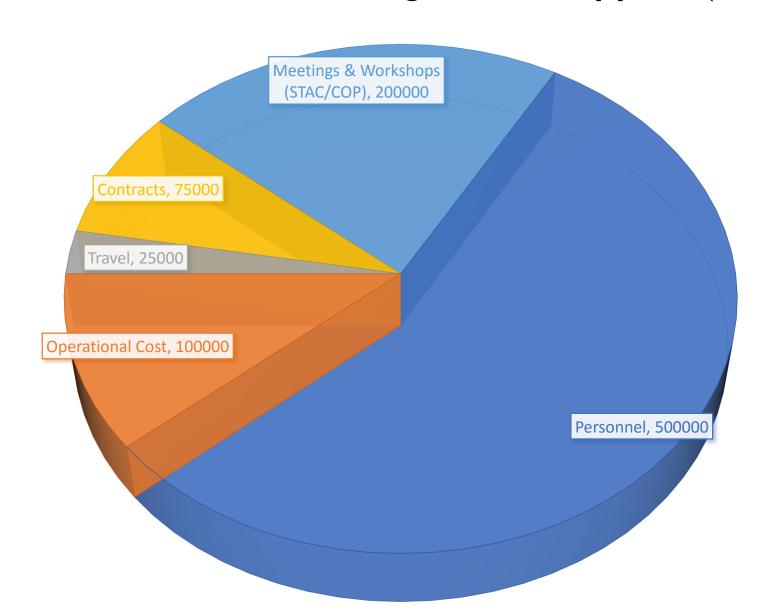
## Overview of Income Sources

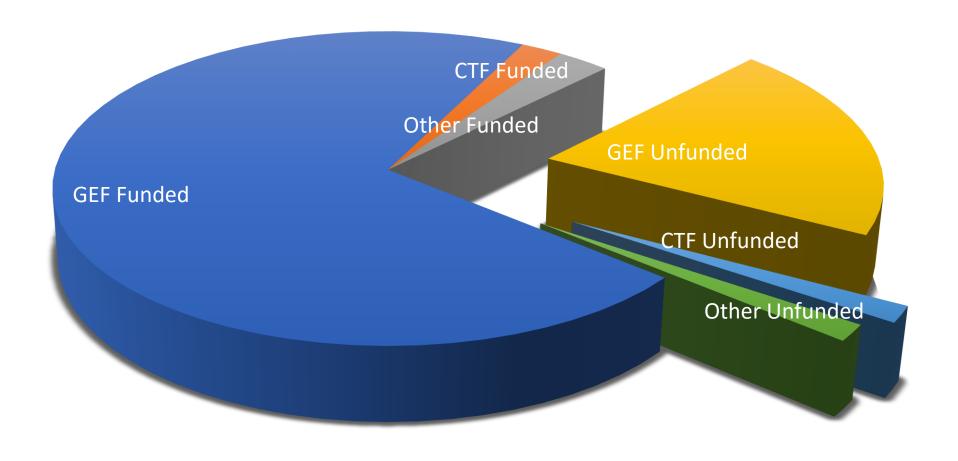
