


EU Benefits through a Circular Economy





EU Circular Economy Action Plan 4 Key areas of action 5 Priority sectors















- SDGs 8,9 → Circular Economy brings higher levels of economic productivity by improving resource efficiency in consumption and production.
- SDGs 6,13,14,15 → improving the environmental quality for citizens, as the circular economy ensures the protection of our ecosystems, the reduction of marine pollution and it contributes to the fight against climate change
- SGDs 12 → fostering the shift towards responsible consumption and production patterns and by sustainable managing all wastes and chemicals.
