Process to COP15

- Special SBSTTA-SBI virtual sessions 15-18 September:
 - Launch of GBO;
 - Online Open Forum on Country Reviews;
 - Information session with the panel of resource mobilization experts;
 - Joint SBSTTA-SBI session on post-2020;
- Bureau considering virtual sessions of SBSTTA and SBI in November and December;
- Face to face SBSTTA/SBI in March 2021;
- WG2020 in mid-2021, with consultation with Colombia;
- COP15 in fourth quarter of 2021 , in consultation with China.

Subsidiary Body on Implementation

- Seven agenda items will support the post-2020 global biodiversity framework:
 - Agenda item 3: Review of progress in the implementation of the Convention and the Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011-2020.
 - Agenda item 5: Post-2020 Process
 - Agenda item 6 (a): Resource mobilization – By COP decision [14/22](#), the SBI will review outputs of the expert panel on resource mobilization (see CBD/SBI/3/5).

Subsidiary Body on Implementation

- Agenda item 6 (b): Financial mechanism – By COP decision [14/23](#), the SBI will prepare proposals for a four-year outcome-oriented framework of programme priorities for the eighth replenishment period (July 2022–June 2026) of the Trust Fund of the Global Environment Facility for the Convention and its Protocols, aligned with the draft post-2020 global biodiversity framework.
- Agenda item 7 (a): Capacity-building, technical and scientific cooperation, and technology transfer – By COP decision [14/24](#), the SBI will consider a draft long-term strategic framework for capacity-building beyond 2020, aligned with the draft post-2020 global biodiversity framework and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. **The SBI will also undertake related work in accordance with and Nagoya Protocol decision [NP-3/5](#).**

- Agenda item 7 (b): Knowledge management and the clearing-house mechanism
- Agenda item 7 (c): Communication
- Agenda item 8: Cooperation with other conventions, international organizations and initiatives
- Agenda item 9: Mechanisms for reporting, assessment and review of implementation – By COP decisions [14/27](#), [14/29](#) and 14/34, the SBI will host a forum on testing a Party-led review process and consider options for enhancing review mechanisms.
- Agenda item 11: Mainstreaming of biodiversity within and across sectors and other strategic actions to enhance implementation

 - The co-chairs of the open-ended working group, to facilitate the consideration of issues related to the development of the post-2020 global biodiversity framework have identified a set of questions for which they would like the input of the Subsidiary Body on Implementation.
