General objectives

- Contribute to the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, facilitating the achievement of the goals and targets related to chemicals and waste in Latin America and the Caribbean
- Support the implementation of international agreements on chemicals and waste in the countries of the region
- Strengthen regional cooperation and facilitate the exchange of information and good practices on the sound management of chemicals and wastes
- Promote mechanisms for technology transfer and capacity building to reduce the use of chemical products and make recommendations at the policy and program level for consideration by the Forum of Ministers of the Environment of Latin America and the Caribbean.

The objective of the project

Survey the current regulations on Lead Acid Batteries (ULAB) in Latin America and the Caribbean to analyze those experiences that have included or wish to include Extended Producer Responsibility (REP) schemes, identifying the main lessons learned and challenges in implementation, in order to draw up a list of guidance recommendations for the region that will allow the countries of Latin America and the Caribbean that so wish to introduce concrete improvements in the management of these wastes, exchange experiences in the different stages of the life cycle chain, and promote technical assistance and regional cooperation.
