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Introduction

1. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure of the Mediterranean Commission on Sustainable Development (MCSD) and in consultation with the Members of the MCSD Steering Committee, the 20th Meeting of the MCSD is being convened on 14-16 June 2023.

2. France generously offered to host the meeting in the municipality of Marseille.

3. Simultaneous interpretation in English and French will be available for the plenary sessions. Working documents will be in English and French. Participants are encouraged to download the documentation on their computers in advance of the session.

4. The following annotations to the Provisional Agenda (Document UNEP/MED WG.560/1) were prepared by the Secretariat to assist the meeting in its deliberations.

5. The meeting will be opened at 10:00 on Wednesday, 14 June 2023, by Mr. Mitja Bricelj, President of the MCSD. After a welcome address from Mr. Hervé Berville, French State Secretary for the Sea, the President of Region Sud (tbc), and the Mayor of Marseille (tbc), the Coordinator of the UNEP/MAP – Barcelona Convention Secretariat will also make opening remarks.

7. The meeting will proceed to the election of the MCSD Steering Committee which, according to Rule 17, is composed of a President, five Vice-presidents and a Rapporteur, on the basis of an equitable geographical distribution, and shall include four members representing the Contracting Parties, including *ex officio* the President of the Bureau of the Contracting Parties, and three representatives from the six groups foreseen by the Terms of Reference of the MCSD.

8. The meeting will be invited to review and adopt the Provisional Agenda contained in Document UNEP/MED WG.560/1 and annotated in the present document.

9. It is expected that the MCSD will discuss all the items of the Agenda during its three-day meeting, including the adoption of conclusions and recommendations. It is envisaged to close the meeting at 18:00 on Friday, 16 June 2021.

10. The Report of the 20th Meeting of the MCSD will be distributed to the Members of the MCSD for their perusal, comments and approval through electronic means.

a) Presentation MED 2050 Foresight Study

16. The Secretariat (Plan Bleu/RAC) will introduce Document UNEP/MED WG.560/4 on the Outcome of the MED 2050 Foresight Study. It provides a description of the methodology applied, a timeline and includes a summary of each of the six scenarios, supporting tables, and presentation. MCSD is expected to provide comments and suggestions (a) on the methodology and proposed planning regarding the elaboration of the transition pathways and (b) opportunities for further dissemination and debate until COP23 and beyond, and (c) embark on a discussion on possible ways and means required to bring the Mediterranean region development on sustainability path.

b) Outcome of the MED 2050 Youth Workshop on the Future of the Mediterranean

17. The Secretariat (Plan Bleu/RAC) will present the outcome of the MED 2050 Youth Workshop on the Future of the Mediterranean. Youth networks representatives will share their views on the MED 2050 Foresight Study.

18. The Roundtable/Panel discussions focused on the theme "Way forward for Sustainable Blue Economy in the Mediterranean" is composed of two consecutive sessions. It will be opened by the French Ambassador delegate for the Mediterranean Sea M. Karim AMELLAL, and the MAP Coordinator. The Roundtable/Panel discussions will be moderated by Ms. Sophie-Dorothée DURON, Head of Department "Maritime and Coastal Areas" DGAMPA.

19. The first panel will set the scene for sustainable blue economy in the Mediterranean, addressing the role of the Regional Seas towards the implementation of the new Global commitments (The BBNJ Treaty, the Treaty on Plastic Pollution and the Post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework), Sustainable Blue Economy financing and investment in the Mediterranean, and Sub-Regional implementation (the Adriatic-Ionian sub-region/EUSAIR: Sub-regional Contingency Plan, ICZM and MSP, MPAs, as well as the food, energy, water and climate security nexus).

20. The second panel will focus on best practices to promote Sustainable Bleu Economy. The panelists will share their experience on issues related to: the development of maritime planning in the Mediterranean as a necessity to reconcile the sustainable development of the maritime economy and the preservation of biodiversity resources and services provided by the Ocean; Sustainable tourism at the post-COVID era; Food, energy, water and climate security nexus; Greening of maritime transport; Benefit of coupling sustainable Bleu Economy and Marine Protected Areas; and A youth perspective on Blue Economy.

21. The Meeting is expected to comment and contribute to the discussion, as appropriate.

22. The outcome of the panel discussions may represent the first elements that the MCSD may consider in view of feeding the relevant discussions at the 23nd Meeting of the Contracting Parties to the Barcelona Convention and its Protocols (COP 23) (Portoroz, Slovenia, December 2023) and in the preparation of its Ministerial Declaration.
