

A global campaign to explore career opportunities:

Cooling Champions: Cool Careers for a Better World



Over the last three decades, the Montreal Protocol promoted the concept of refrigerant management as an integrated approach for controlling and minimizing unwanted emissions and consumption of refrigerants especially when servicing refrigeration and air conditioning applications and systems.
