

















**KEY MESSAGES:** 

• Women and youth are particularly vulnerable to negative impacts of sargassum influxes.

Sargassum Influx Management

- There is a dearth of gender-differentiated data and information on sargassum impacts to support the development of appropriate, evidence-based responses and policies.
- There have been several advances in sargassum research and development in the last decade spearheaded by women and youth champions.
- Youth have been instrumental in creating sargassum-inspired music and many forms of artistic expression.
- Sargassum-kissed shores in the Caribbean have been a catalyst for innovation and may offer solutions for a sustainable and equitable blue recovery to the COVID-19 crisis.

Women and youth have an important role to play in:



Advocating for inclusion in decision-making processes.



Using influencer marketing and other innovative communication tools to raise the awareness of their peers.



Advancing innovation in sargassum product development and technology/equipment to promote effective clean-up/harvest operations.



Participating in citizen science initiatives and ground truthing activities that help to validate forecasts.



Promoting women-owned sargassum related businesses.

#### Female Innovator, Kerri-Ann Bovell





Barbadian Innovator Kerri-Ann Bovell is developing a bioplastic packaging alternative made from sargassum seaweed and starch sourced from local food waste. Her achievements to date include being a semi-finalist in the 2019 Climate Launchpad, the world's largest green business competition held in Amsterdam. She was also a top performer in the UNDP Blue Lab "Blue Tank" Programme and in 2020 her start-up EcoMycö was also selected as an incubatee in the Bloom Barbados Cleantech Cluster. Read more here

## **Policy Actions**



Promote the equitable participation of women and women's groups in decision-making processes for sargassum management.



Engage youth at policy-making and decision- making levels on issues that are related to youth involvement in sargassum management and innovation.



Foster intergenerational partnerships that encourage the exchange of ideas and experiences, mutual learning, and meaningful action across generations.



Integrate sargassum science and management in related subjects in school curricula.



Appoint women and youth to decision-making organs, such as sargassum task forces/sargassum management committees, and allow leadership in the implementation of activities.



Improve the economic empowerment of women and youth in the sargassum valuechain in the Caribbean by supporting entrepreneurship and facilitating access to venture capital.



Develop gender-responsive sargassum adaptive management strategies that address influxes as a hazard and an opportunity.
