## STATEMENT BY DELEGATION OF INDONESIA AT THE SECOND SUBSTANTIVE CONSULTATIVE MEETING ON UNGA RESOLUTION 73/333 HELD ON 17-19 NOVEMBER 2021

Co-facilitators,

Indonesia associates itself with statement delivered by Malawi on behalf of the Group of 77 and China.

Further to the above, our delegation would like to emphasize the following points in our national capacity:

- Indonesia is of the view that draft political declaration for 73/333 is a member state driven process. This should entail an open, transparent and inclusive process, allowing for textual amendments of the current draft, with the view to achieve consensus.
- Indonesia emphasizes the need to clearly reflect the well-established principle of common but differentiated responsibilities in the draft political declaration.
- Indonesia also underscores the need for the political declaration to clearly express itself on means of implementation, including through financing, capacity building, and technology transfer.

Indonesia looks forward for a fruitful discussion and stands ready to engage constructively.
