Proposed approach



- **Duration:** 90 minutes
- Participants: Pre-registered Contributing Ministers (15-20), Invited Guests (3-5),
 High Level Moderator, Rapporteur (?)

Structure

- Welcome and opening remarks by the moderator
- Short opening remarks by Invited Guests
- Round of answers to guiding questions
- Pre-registered Contributing Ministers or HoD make their statements and respond to the remarks made by Invited Guests.
- Short summary of takeaway messages by moderator or rapporteur
- Final remarks and closing of the dialogue by the moderator



Proposed approach







The first hemicycle will be occupied by the pre-registered Contributing Ministers (or HoD). In the front will be the Invited Guests and the Moderator.







Key principles and next steps



The organization of the Leadership Dialogues will take into consideration balanced regional and gender representation.

The dialogues will be designed to contribute towards the overall theme adopted for the special session.

The Secretariat will develop a guidance note that will be circulated in January.

Once the guidance note is made available, the process to receive registrations from Contributing Ministers and HoD will be initiated.

Member States will be kindly encouraged to express their interest to participate in the dialogues.
