## Input by Israel to UNEA-5 draft Ministerial Declaration

- 1. Israel strongly supports the addition of <u>invasive species</u> as one of the direct threats to biodiversity (Article 5); the reference to <u>rechanneling financial flows</u> (Article 7), which is essential to the transformational change required to halt the deterioration of nature and its services; and the addition of "<u>actively conserving</u>" (Article 15).
- 2. Article 15: In our opinion, the narrative regarding which ecosystems are important for the provision of ecosystem services, including mitigation of climate change, is not comprehensive enough. In particular, semi-arid / desert systems are not mentioned (they are only mentioned in the negative context of desertification). It is therefore proposed to add <u>grasslands and shrublands</u> to the list of ecosystems given as an example (or alternatively, delete the list altogether).
- 3. Article 16: The article seems a bit out of context. We suggest mentioning the importance of best available science <u>also for biodiversity</u> and not only for climate.
