

The biweekly growth rate on any given date measures the percentage change in the number of new confirmed cases over the last 14 days, relative to the number in the previous 14 days.











UN COVID Facility bed occupancy trend





The absence of UN mechanism patients indicates the current reduced need for medevac from other countries despite the recent global surge in cases

- The numbers of fully vaccinated reporting positive results is rising with the possibly attributable to the new variant. Presentation remains mild with no ICU or HDU admissions among vaccinated personnel.
- A large number pending vaccination status as we await confirmation

Vaccination drive

- >95% of staff have been fully vaccinated
- Currently running the booster campaign open for those who are 6 months past their 2nd dose
- Deploying Moderna, Pfizer and Astra Zeneca vaccines
