**REPORT OF THE MEETING ON COASTAL AREAS MANAGEMENT
PROGRAMME (CAMP) FOR THE BAY OF IZMIR**

1. The meeting was held on 16 June 1993 in the premises of the Metropolitan Municipality of Izmir (MMI). The list of participants is enclosed as Annex I to this report.
2. The main topic of the meeting was the preparation for the presentation of the results of the Coastal Areas Management Programme (CAMP) for the Bay of Izmir and the main conclusions are given below.
3. The proposed title of the meeting is "Presentation of Results of the Coastal Areas Management Programme for the Bay of Izmir".
4. It was agreed that the meeting should be for two days. The provisional agenda, as agreed, is enclosed as Annex II to this report.
5. The morning session of the first day will be devoted to the opening and introductory remarks and the presentation of the synthesis of results including the conclusions and recommendations. The afternoon session of the first day will be devoted to the presentation of the results of each activity as well as the results of some important activities which were not performed in the framework of CAMP Izmir but are relevant to it.
6. The morning session of the second day will be devoted to discussion of the results, conclusions and recommendations as well as proposals for their amendments. The afternoon session of the second day will be devoted to the adoption of conclusions and recommendations.
7. It was proposed that the tentative days of the meeting be 22 and 23 September 1993 and that the second option be 29 and 30 September 1993. It was agreed that it is very important that H.E. the Minister of the Environment and the Mayor of Izmir attend the meeting, at least during the morning session of the first day.
8. It was proposed that Professor Cemal Arkon, "9 September" University, Izmir, chairs the meeting and if he is not able to do so, then that Professor Orhan Uslu of the same University chairs it.
9. As a place for the meeting in Izmir, it was suggested (by priority order): Hotel Hilton, Chamber of Commerce, Chamber of Industry, Grand Hotel. Simultaneous interpretation between English and Turkish will be arranged.
10. The Turkish side will cover all costs relevant to the meeting, including the rental of the meeting room and the interpretation and the provision of all equipment necessary for the presentation. The municipality will arrange to provide large screen computer projection facilities.
11. A list of documents which will be distributed to the participants was agreed upon as presented in Annex III to this report. The details for the preparation of these documents are given in paragraphs 16 to 21 of this report.
12. The Turkish side will organize the TV coverage of the meeting and press conference.
13. A preliminary list of persons to be invited will be prepared by the Ministry of the Environment for the persons to be invited by the Minister and by the Metropolitan Municipality of Izmir for the persons to be invited by the Mayor. After exchange of such preliminary lists (by 15 July 1993), the final lists will be prepared by the Ministry and by the Municipality. Both final lists should be sent to Mr L. Jeftic by Ms N. Talu by the end of July 1993. The Co-ordinator of the Mediterranean Action Plan will invite foreign participants. The tentative list of these foreign participants is: Professor S. Busuttill, Mr L. Jeftic, Mr A. Pavasovic, Mr I. Trumbic, Mr U. Marinov, Mr F. Juhasz and Mr V. Veldic. The possible participation of Blue Plan and Specially Protected Areas Regional Activity Centres will be decided in due time.

14. The Minister of the Environment will invite representatives of the World Bank, UNDP, EEC and other financial institutions, as appropriate.
15. The Ministry of the environment will explore the feasibility to organize the presentation of CAMP for the Bay of Izmir also in Ankara, to which representatives of the Black Sea programme and some Black Sea countries could be invited. The decision on such presentation could be taken after the presentation in Izmir.
16. Ms N. Talu will explore the feasibility of organizing a meeting with representatives of the World Bank on the possibility of financing the follow-up activities for CAMP for the Bay of Izmir.
17. Mr I. Trumbic will prepare the document "Coastal Areas Management Programme for the Bay of Izmir: A Synthesis Report". The document should be 20-40 pages long plus tables, diagrams and figures. It should include an executive summary (2 pages), the history of CAMP Izmir, basic information, synthesis of results, conclusions and recommendations. This document should be prepared by 15 August 1993 and should be cleared by the Ministry of Environment, MMI and the Mediterranean Co-ordinating Unit. The cover page will have three logos (Ministry of Environment, MMI and UNEP/MAP). A camera ready copy will be sent from PAP/RAC to the Ministry which will arrange for reproduction.
18. The document "Integrated Coastal Master Plan for the Metropolitan Municipality and the Bay of Izmir: A report on the Preparatory Activity" will be prepared by Mr I. Trumbic by 15 August 1993 and sent to the Ministry for reproduction.
19. Mr L. Jetic will send by 30 June to Ms N. Talu 100 copies of the study on Costs and Benefits of Control of Land-based Sources of Pollution for the Bay of Izmir (MAP Technical Reports Series No 72).
20. The document on Geographical Information System will be reproduced by the Ministry of Environment.
21. The Ministry of Environment will prepare the summary of the document on Environmental Impact Assessment and will reproduce both the summary and the document.
