**LOGISTICS NOTES**

Dear Delegate,

With reference to the "**Regional Seas Annual Meeting**" scheduled from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> May 2022 in Seychelles. Please find below logistical notes for your information.

**1. VISA**

All delegates must hold a valid passport with validity of at least 06 (six) months from the date of entry into Seychelles.

**2. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR VISITING SEYCHELLES**

Delegates are required to fill in mandatory Travel Authorization form to the Seychelles. The form can be accessed on the official government website <https://seychelles.govtas.com>

To apply for the Travel Authorization, delegates will need proof of full COVID-19 vaccination or negative COVID-19 test result, passport, flight details, copies of the accommodation bookings for the entire stay. Delegates are required to provide confirmed bookings for every night, and credit/debit card to pay the fee.

Citizens only need to provide proof of vaccine or negative COVID-19 test result and passport. The application is free for Seychelles passport holders. Applications are reviewed in 9 hours or less.

There is no yellow fever (YF) in Seychelles and as a precaution, a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate is required from travelers over 1 year of age who come from or who have passed through a country or area where yellow fever is endemic within the preceding 6 days

**3. ACCOMMODATION**

Delegates are kindly requested to settle the hotel fees directly at the hotel.

#### **4. MEETING VENUE**

The meeting will be held at Eden Bleu

#### **5. TRANSPORTATION**

Delegates must make their own travel arrangement from the airport to their respective accommodation and vice-versa.

#### **6. REGISTRATION**

Registration will start at 08.30- 09.00 on all three days of the meeting.

#### **7. DRESSCODE**

A set of comfortable outdoor clothing as there would be a site visit.

#### **8. WEATHER**

May is usually the start of the dry period. The temperature in May averages from 25°C to 30°C. We experience a bit of rain every now and then.

#### **9. CURRENCY**

The unit of currency is the Seychelles rupee (scr). The average exchange rate at the moment is 1 \$ = 14.35 scr, 1 EUR= 15.5 scr and 1 GBP=18.7 scr. These rates may vary on a day to day basis. A money changer is available at the airport.

#### **10. VOLTAGE AND TYPES OF PINS**

In Seychelles the power sockets are of type C and G

Wi-Fi will be provided free of charge in the meeting rooms and for the duration of the meeting.
