MULTILATERAL TREATIES IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENT TO WHICH MEDITERRANEAN COUNTRIES ARE PARTIES

Introduction

The Eighth Ordinary Meeting of the Contracting Parties to the Convention for the Protection of the Mediterranean Sea against pollution (Antalya, Turkey, 12-15 October 1993) decided the following:

Urged the Contracting Parties that have not yet done so, to ratify the Land-Based Sources protocol (LBS), the Specially Protected Areas protocol (SPA), the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships (1973) and its related protocol (1978) (MARPOL 73/78), the International Convention on Oil Pollution Preparedness, Response and Cooperation (OPRC) (1990), the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage (1969), the International Convention on the Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil pollution Damage (1971) and the Basel Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and their Disposal (1989).

Furthermore, the Antalya Meeting invited the Contracting Parties to review their position with respect to the international conventions, protocols and agreements and if possible to ensure the early signature of these instruments which may have a positive influence on the Mediterranean Basin -eg. CFC's, Biological Diversity, Climate Changes or the preparation of appropriate conventions such as the convention concerning desertification.

Accordingly, and with a view to assisting the Contracting Parties to implement these decisions, the Secretariat has prepared this information paper on various relevant environmental conventions and agreements which have relevance to the work of the Mediterranean Action Plan (MAP) and to which Mediterranean Countries are already parties. For those relevant environmental conventions which have not yet entered into force, the Signatories are also indicated. The list will be further reviewed in order to show the today status of participation (Signature, Ratification, Accession, Approval) in these conventions and agreements, following the structure of the first page of this paper concerning the Barcelona Convention and its related protocols, on the basis of available information at the Co-ordinating Unit of the Mediterranean Action Plan as at 31 December 1993.
