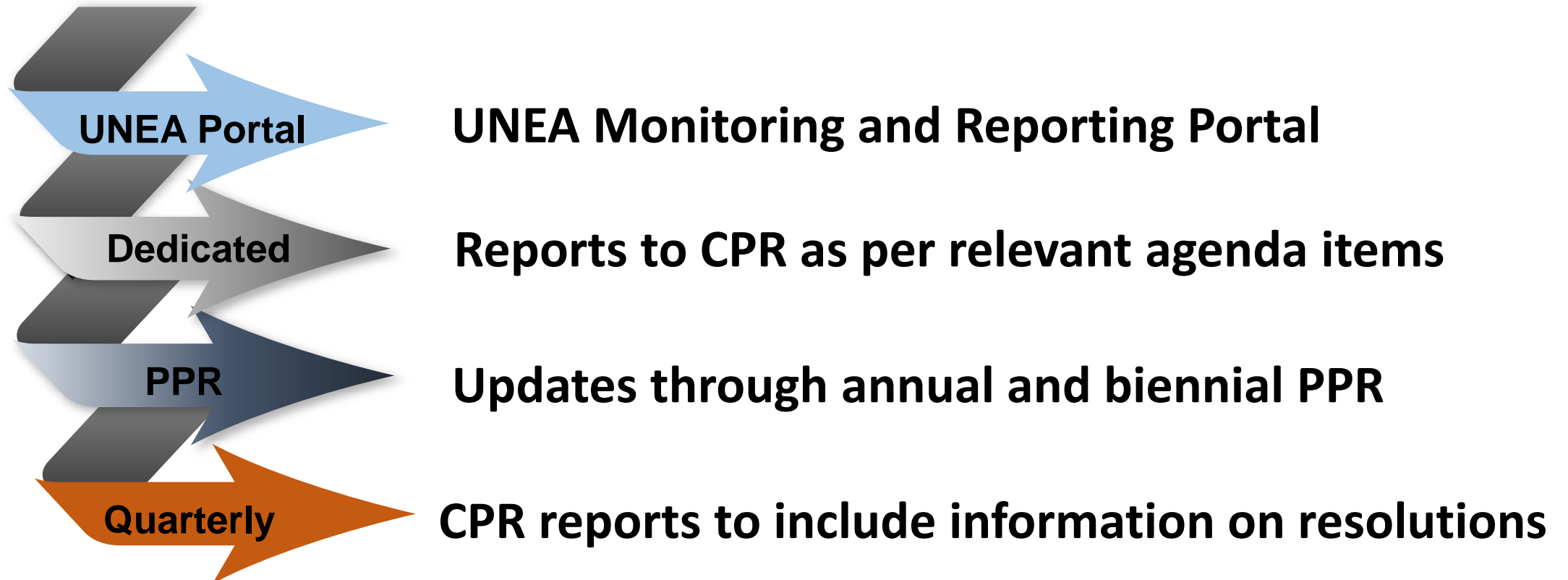

Current Resolutions Reporting Framework

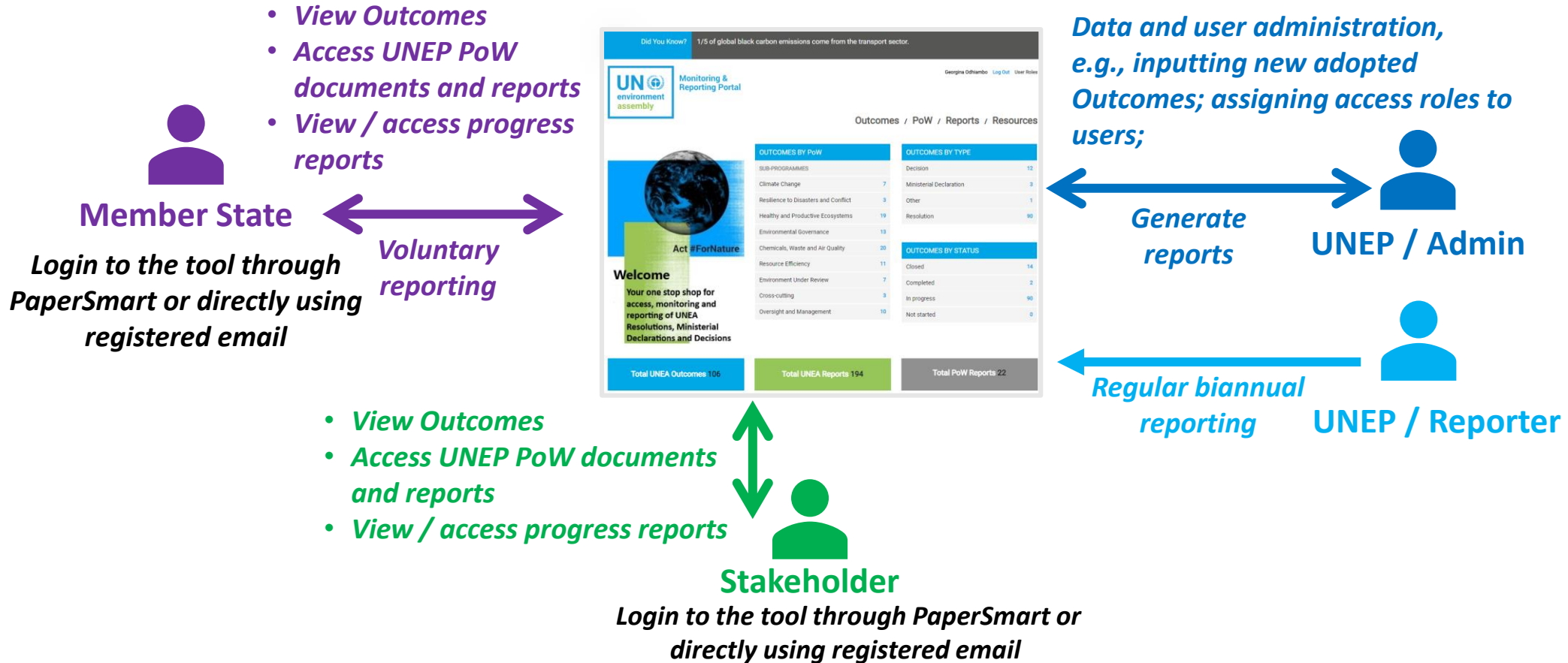


Introduction

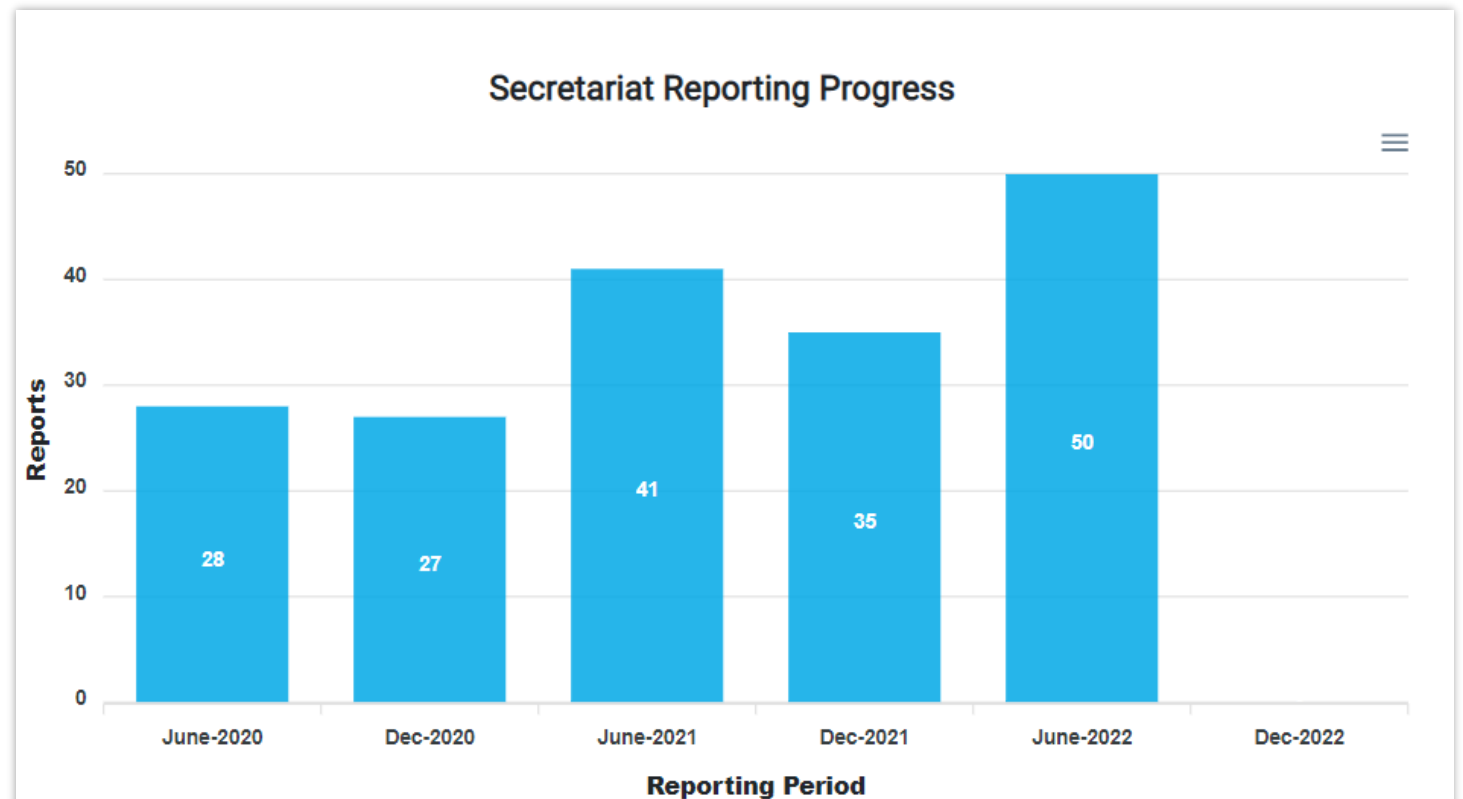

The portal's home page now displays a summary of outcome progress reports submitted by the Secretariat for each biannual cycle.

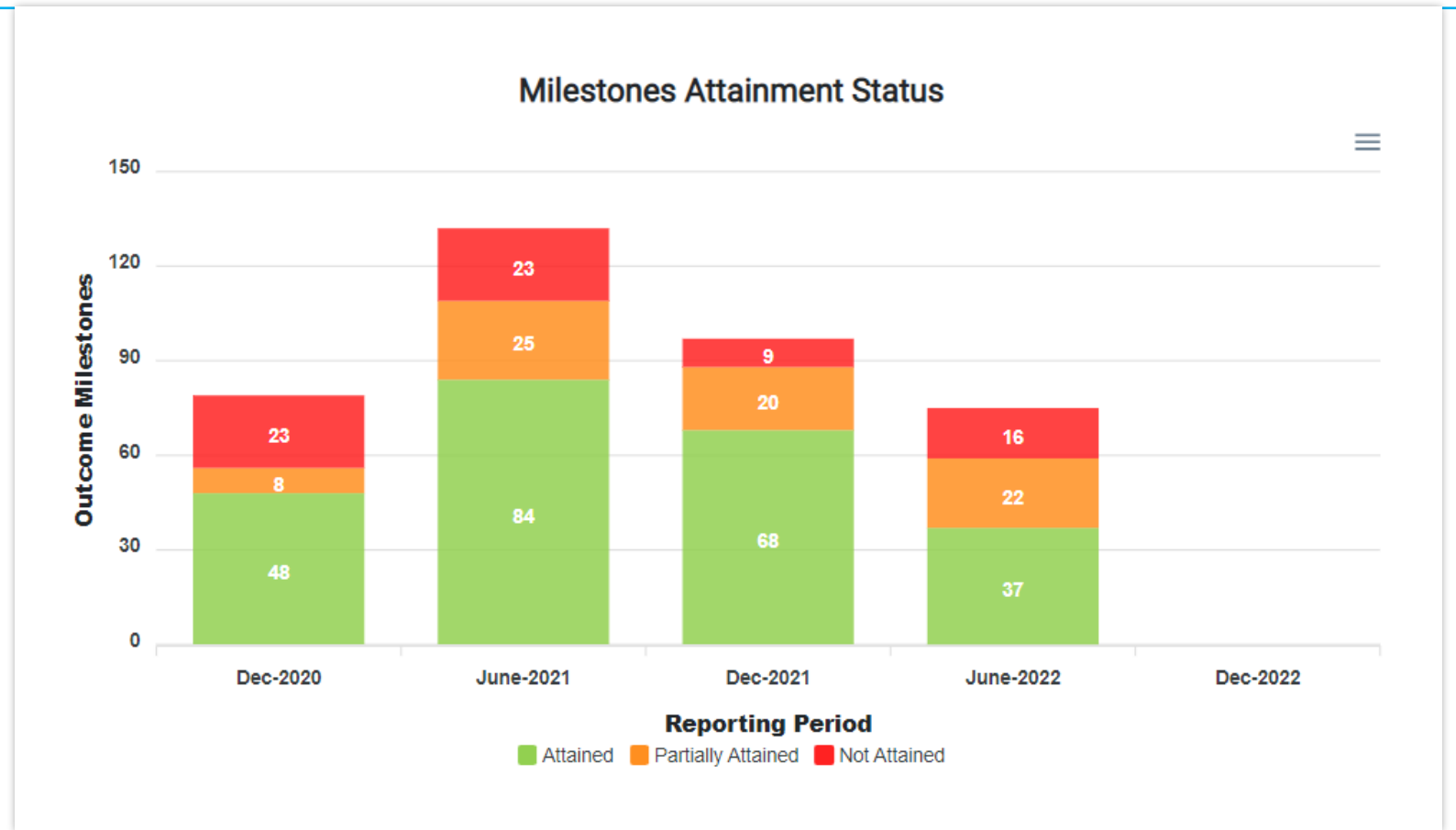
A total of **181** UNEA Outcome reports have been submitted by the Secretariat since June 2020.

Member States can now designate reporting focal points to report on behalf of their countries.


So far, 20 national reporting focal points have been designated by 5 countries.
