Kenya's Intervention during the 9th Annual Subcommittee Meeting of the CPR on Agenda Item 9: Consultation on the theme for the sixth session of the United Nations Environment Assembly.

I thank you chair for the opportunity,

- 1. Kenya would like to thank the Executive Director, the President of UNEA 6 and the entire Secretariat for shedding light on the process to define the UNEA 6 theme through comprehensive reports and presentations.
- 2. While aligning itself with the statement of the African group, Kenya takes note of the three options and acknowledges that these will form an important base for discussions.
- 3. It is important to understand where we are coming from that is since UNEA 1 to now UNEA 5.2 and how best we can implement resolutions that have since been adopted.
- 4. Kenya notes that there is indeed a wealth of repository information such as the report on 'Making Peace with Nature, a scientific blueprint to tackle the climate, biodiversity and pollution emergencies' from which a theme for UNEA 6 can be drawn.
- 5. In this regard, Kenya appreciates the joint Bureaus of UNEA 6 and the CPR Bureau for taking their time to consider the lessons learned document of UNEA 5. We reiterate that the clearer a theme is the more actionable it will be.
- 6. Kenya which anchors itself on multilateral consensus, wishes to stress the need for a transparent, participatory and allinclusive process.
- 7. Kenya is looking forward to engaging actively in the consultations as provided in the roadmap leading to the final decision on the theme.
