







Structuring the discussions / Agenda item 4

Discussions will cover two different but related considerations:

- 1) What should be included in the legally binding instrument?
- 2) How could the process be structured in order to reach agreement by the end of 2024?



Further potential questions that could facilitate discussions at INC-1 (Scenario Note paras 26 & 27)

- 1. Considerations for the legally binding instrument:
 - (a) Which problem or problems will the instrument aim to address? How will the aim be reflected in the instrument?
 - (b)What core obligations, control measures and voluntary approaches would provide a comprehensive approach to addressing the problem or problems?
 - (c) How can the instrument create an incentive-based approach and enabling environment such that it is in everyone's interest to implement their obligations?
- 2. Considerations in structuring the process to reach agreement:
 - (a)On what issues can early agreement be envisaged?
 - (b) What areas require further work to be undertaken by the secretariat or by the Chair of the committee? By when?
 - (c) How can the intergovernmental negotiating committee ensure that the interests of all stakeholders are considered and contribute to the process of elaborating the instrument?



Possible outcomes of INC-1:

- a. Preliminary discussion on possible options for scope, objectives & structure;
- b. Explored issues in paragraphs 3 and 4 of UNEA resolution 5/14;
- c. Identified provisions that will require significant further consideration and provisions on which agreement is likely to be reached more readily;
- d. Discussed standard articles on final provisions, and agree in principle or agree on need for further discussion;
- e. Agreed to a timetable for further discussion of provisions that is consistent with the need to conclude the negotiations by 2024;
- f. Discussed sequencing and clustering of the committee's work;
- g. Requested the secretariat for any additional information or analysis required for the INC, including a possible mandate to prepare a zero-draft text of the instrument for consideration at INC-2;
- h. Agreed on the dates, venue and provisional agenda of INC-2;
- i. Agreed on any intersessional work to be carried out in 2023;
- j. Discussed the possibility of convening future multi-stakeholder forums.
