

Proposal from the USA and the EU for a consolidated language of paragraph 2 of Rule 37, reflecting consultations with interested parties having expressed concern on this matter at the OEWG

Rule 37

1. Each Member shall have one vote, except as provided for in paragraph 2 of the present rule.
2. A regional economic integration organization shall, on matters within its competence, exercise its right to vote with a number of votes equal to [the number of its member States participating in the Committee] [the number of its member States duly accredited and present at the time of the vote]. Such an organization shall not exercise its right to vote if any of its member States exercises its right to vote, and vice versa.
