Proposal from the USA and the EU for a consolidated language of paragraph 2 of Rule 37, reflecting consultations with interested parties having expressed concern on this matter at the OEWG

Rule 37

- 1. Each Member shall have one vote, except as provided for in paragraph 2 of the present rule.
- 2. A regional economic integration organization shall, on matters within its competence, exercise its right to vote with a number of votes equal to [the number of its member States participating in the Committee] [the number of its member States duly accredited and present at the time of the vote]. Such an organization shall not exercise its right to vote if any of its member States exercises its right to vote, and vice versa.
