Agenda item 5: Preparations for the sixth session of the United Nations Environment Assembly

This note, entitled "Draft roadmap for an inclusive, participatory and transparent consultation process on the draft ministerial declaration of the sixth session of the United Nations Environment Assembly" has been developed by the Presidency for the sixth session of the United Nations Environment Assembly with inputs from the Secretariat and guidance from the Bureaux of the United Nations Environment Assembly and the Committee of Permanent Representatives, for discussion under agenda item 5 –Preparations for the sixth session of the UN Environment Assembly.

The note and attached roadmap outline the proposed milestones and key dates for the process for drafting and convening of the consultations leading up to the adoption of a draft ministerial declaration at the sixth session of the UN Environment Assembly (UNEA-6), under the leadership of the UNEA President, building on established practice and experience gained for this process since UNEA-1. It proposes a zero draft declaration from the Presidency, followed by open and transparent consultations on a zero draft, a first draft, a second draft, and a final draft to be tabled for adoption during the high-level segment of UNEA-6 in February/March 2024.

Members of the Committee as well as observers and major groups and stakeholders are invited to provide further guidance to the President of UNEA-6 on how to ensure the broadest possible ownership for the UNEA-6 ministerial declaration through an inclusive, participatory and transparent consultation process.

Draft roadmap for an inclusive, participatory and transparent consultation process on the draft ministerial declaration of the sixth session of the United Nations Environment Assembly

Following the established practice of the previous sessions of the United Nations Environment Assembly (UNEA), it is expected that the UNEA-6 will consider for adoption by consensus a concise and an action-oriented draft ministerial declaration during its high-level segment in February/March 2024, providing high-level political guidance on the implementation of the UNEA-6 theme.

The UNEA Presidency provides a leadership role, as penholder and facilitator for consultations with Member States and UNEA-accredited Observers and Major Groups and Stakeholders in preparation for the adoption of the draft ministerial declaration, ensuring the broadest possible ownership through an open-ended, inclusive and transparent consultations.

Throughout the consultation process, the UNEA Presidency will be guided and supported by the Members of the UNEA and CPR Bureaus.

Traditionally, the consultation process has been initiated by the President soon after agreement on the theme for the session, through a letter addressed to all Member States, Observers and Major Groups and Stakeholders, whereby they are invited to submit their initial inputs on the zero draft declaration presented by the Presidency. A similar approach is proposed for the UNEA-6 consultation process on a ministerial declaration.

Taking into account the inputs received on the zero draft, a first draft ministerial declaration will then be circulated together with a timeline for open-ended informal consultations. On the basis of further inputs from these consultations, a second draft will be made available. Following further consultations, the Presidency will make available a final draft for consideration at the 6th meeting of the Open-ended Committee of Permanent Representatives and subsequent adoption by consensus during the high-level segment of UNEA.

In support of the consultation process, all written inputs will be made available on a dedicated website. As a reference, the inputs to the UNEA-5 ministerial declaration were made available here.

To ensure a well-planned, inclusive and transparent preparatory process on the development of a draft ministerial declaration, the UNEA-6 Presidency has put forward the attached draft roadmap, outlining the key milestones and timelines for consultations with Member States, observers and major groups and stakeholders for the adoption of a draft ministerial declaration at UNEA-6.

Draft roadmap for the preparation of a draft ministerial declaration of the sixth session of the UN Environment Assembly (UNEA-6)

30 January 2023	Agreement on a theme for UNEA-6 and consideration of a draft roadmap at the joint Bureaus meeting to ensure an inclusive, participatory and transparent consultation process towards an agreement on a draft ministerial declaration.
March 2023	 Presentation of the draft roadmap by the UNEA Presidency at the 161st meeting of the CPR. Finalization of the roadmap by the UNEA Presidency based on the guidance provided by the UNEA and CPR Bureaus and taking into account feedback provided at the 161st CPR meeting. Circulation of a letter from the UNEA President informing of the roadmap.
April 2023	 Circulation of a zero draft ministerial declaration through a letter from the UNEA President also inviting Member States, observers and major groups and stakeholders to provide written inputs on the zero draft ministerial declaration, with a deadline of the end of May 2023. Inputs submitted in writing will be made available on a dedicated website.
10 May 2023	 Preliminary discussion at the UNEA Bureau meeting on the zero draft ministerial declaration and additional elements to be included.
End of May 2023	Deadline for the submission of inputs – to be upload on a dedicated website.
Mid-June 2023	First Informal Consultations with Member States [hybrid], observers and major groups and stakeholders on the zero draft ministerial declaration in the margins of the 162nd CPR meeting
5 July 2023	• Consultations with major groups and stakeholders on the zero draft ministerial declaration, in advance of the joint Bureaus retreat.
6-7 July 2023	• Further consideration of the zero draft at the joint Bureaux retreat in Morocco, with the objective to provide further guidance to the Presidency on the zero draft.
End of July 2023	• Circulation of a letter from the President of UNEA transmitting the first draft ministerial declaration and inviting Member States, observers and major groups and stakeholders to provide written inputs and comments on the first draft with a deadline of the end of August 2023.
End of Aug 2023	Deadline for the submission of inputs – to be uploaded on a dedicated website.
Mid-Sept 2023	 Circulation of a letter from the President of UNEA transmitting the revised first draft of the ministerial declaration on the basis of inputs and contributions received from Member States, observers and major groups and stakeholders Second Informal Consultations [hybrid] on the revised first draft of the ministerial declaration
End of September	Circulation of a letter from the President of UNEA transmitting the second draft ministerial declaration and inviting Member States, observers and major groups and stakeholders to provide written inputs and comments with a deadline of mid-October 2023.
18 Oct 2023	Meeting of the UNEA Bureau to consider the second draft ministerial declaration.
End Oct 2023	Deadline for the submission of additional inputs – to be uploaded on a dedicated website.
Early Nov 2023	Circulation of a letter from the President of UNEA transmitting the revised second draft ministerial declaration and inviting Member States, observers and major groups and stakeholders to provide inputs and comments at the 10 th meeting of the annual subcommittee of the CPR (ASC-10).
End of Nov 2023 ²	Hybrid format consultation with Member States, observers and major groups and stakeholders at ASC-10 under the leadership of the UNEA Presidency.
