

## INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (IGOs)

Participation in the INC-2 will be open to the following accredited Intergovernmental Organizations:

- Those with observer status with the [General Assembly](#) (GA).
- Those who have participated in the previous sessions of the [United Nations Environment Assembly](#) (UNEA) and the Committee of Permanent Representatives (CPR).
- Those accredited to participate in the meetings of the governing bodies of [Multilateral Environmental Agreements \(MEAs\) and regional environment conventions administered by UNEP](#).

**Organizations that fall within one of the categories listed above will be able to register up to five (5) representatives through the online registration system INDICO to participate as observers.** To access the registration portal for IGOs please click here: [Accredited IGOs Registration](#).

Each participant will be required to register individually. Please be reminded that as part of the registration process, the following documentation will need to be uploaded to INDICO at the time of the registration:

1. Copy of the nomination letter containing the names and functional titles of the delegation (composition of delegation).
2. A passport-size colour photograph (with white, grey, or neutral colour background).
3. The passport bio page.

Please note that the review and verification process of online registrations may take up to 4-5 working days.

**Deadline for registration to participate in the INC-2 is 28 April 2023.**

**There will be no on-site registration.**

## Non-accredited Intergovernmental Organizations

Other IGOs interested in obtaining ad hoc accreditation for the second session of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee can submit an application addressed to the Executive Secretary of the Secretariat of the INC requesting accreditation. Applications can be sent to [unep-sgb@un.org](mailto:unep-sgb@un.org).

The following supporting documentation should be submitted as part of the application:

1. Letter from the head of the organization on the organization's letterhead addressed to the Secretary of the INC, with the original signature and date of signature.
2. Copy of the treaty establishing the organization.
3. Detail the international scope of the organization's activities, such as headquarters and regional offices in different countries, evidence of engagement in more than one country, evidence of engagement with international organizations, and activities that have an impact beyond one country.

4. Proof of engagement in the field of environment such as annual reports, conference and seminar reports, recent press releases and copies of media statements, newsletters and other periodicals.

**Deadline for ad hoc accreditation to participate in the INC-2 is 14 April.**

No more applications will be accepted after this deadline.
