

STAKEHOLDERS

Accredited organizations that fall under the following categories can register to participate as observers for INC-2:

- Non-governmental organizations (NGOs) in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) ([Special, General or Roster consultative status](#)).
You can check if your organization has consultative status with ECOSOC [here](#).
- Organizations accredited to UNEP and invited to participate in the sessions of the United Nations Environment Assembly (UNEA).
You can check if your organization is UNEP accredited [here](#).
- Organizations accredited to the governing bodies of the Multilateral Environmental Agreements (MEAs) and regional environment agreements administered by UNEP.

If your organization is not accredited to ECOSOC, UNEP, or to a UNEP managed MEAs please scroll down.

Eligible organizations that belong to the above-mentioned categories will be able to register up to five (5) representatives through the registration system INDICO. To register please click here: [stakeholders' registration](#).

The following documents must be uploaded on the INDICO registration form at the time of registration:

1. A nomination letter with the organization's letterhead, containing the full names and functional titles of the representatives, with the signature of the person responsible for the organization.
2. A passport-size colour photograph (with white, grey or neutral colour background) of the representative.
3. The passport bio page of the representative.

Please note that the review and verification process of online registrations may take up to 4-5 working days.

A participant must be at least 18 years old to attend the INC-1. No registrations will be accepted via email.

Deadline for registration to participate in the INC-2 is 28 April 2023.

There will be no on-site registration.

Organisations that are not accredited to ECOSOC, UNEP, or to any UNEP managed MEAs

Organizations, whose work is relevant to the INC, but who do NOT belong to the above-mentioned categories can apply to get accredited to the United Nations Environment Assembly.

The deadline to submit the application for UNEP accreditation is 31 March.
