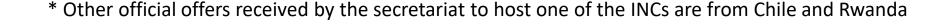

1. Introduction – INC meetings timetable

- i. Open-Ended Working Group (OEWG) in Dakar, from 30 May to 1 June 2022
- ii. INC-1 was held in Uruguay from 28 November to 2 December 2022.
- iii. INC-2 will take place in France from 29 May to 2 June 2023.
- iv. INC-3 proposed to be held in Kenya from 13 to 17 November 2023.
- v. INC-4 proposed to be held in Canada in spring 2024.
- vi. INC-5 proposed to be held in the Republic of Korea in autumn 2024.
- vii. Diplomatic conference in 2025 (current offers Ecuador, Peru, Rwanda, Senegal)

A Host Government is responsible for covering:

- 1. Venue and all related costs
- 2. Conference services support, including interpretation costs, report writers, in-session translation of documents, and others
- 3. INC Secretariat staff travel costs
- 4. UN Department of Security and Safety costs

- The above INC-1 costs reflect only costs incurred by the secretariat.
- At INC-1 the secretariat was only able to fund 1 delegate (109 funded).
- UNEP covered the costs for the multi-stakeholder. Travel costs for 9 participants from Major Groups and Stakeholders came from INC budget.
- Beyond INC secretariat staff (6), the secretariat funded additional 19 personnel to support in different capacities: support for registration, DSA distribution and participants' management, document management, legal support, support the MSF and the stakeholders' dialogue on 29 November.

- Projections for 2023 -2024 are a total of USD. 11.1 million: secured funds of USD. 3.9 million, with a funding gap of USD. 7.2 million
- The gap is expected to be further offset by host countries, as part of the hosting arrangements, and by the pledges from Japan and the United Kingdom once the contributions are received by UNEP.
- Increase in projection from INC-1 estimate is due to the additional number of sponsored delegates (1+1) per eligible country, for the next 4 meetings.

- The projection for regional consultations is USD. 2 million for the meetings in 4 UN regions, to take place before the INC meetings (starting with INC-3).
- The regional meetings are to be held subject to availability of funds, and to be organized prior to INC meetings, calculated in a base for 4 UN regions (except WEOG).
- The overall funding gap is **USD. 5 million** (this will further be offset by the pledge of Japan and the United Kingdom once it is realized).



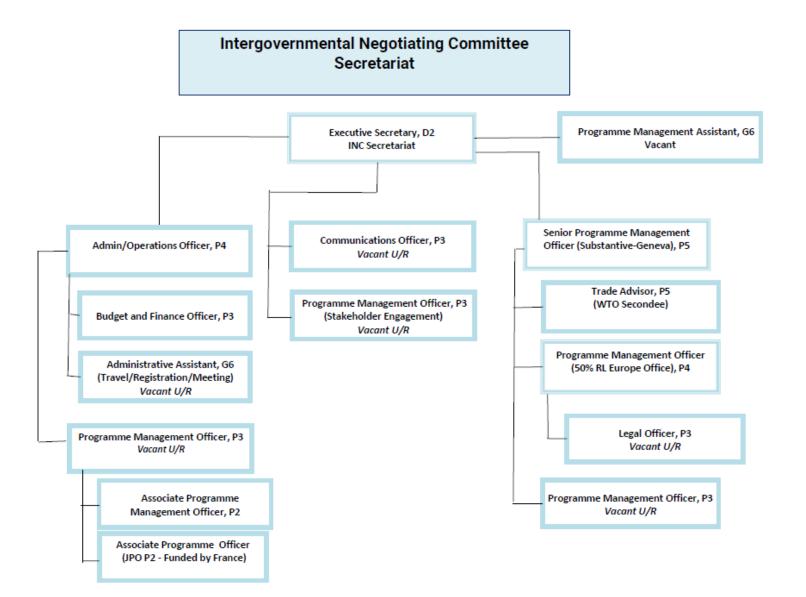

- Staff costs projections for the INC process: USD. 8.6 million for the next four years
- Secured resources: USD. 2.7 million, giving a funding gap of USD. 5.9 million.
- The available funds, majorly covers year 2022 actual staff costs and 2023 projection.
- Thus, the **funding gap**: **USD. 5.9 million** is for the 2024 and 2025 (this is will further be offset by the pledge of Japan once it is realized).
- Other costs (contractual services, travel, fixed operations) are estimated at
 USD 1.4 million, secured USD. 0.9 million and funding gap USD. 0.5 million.

Total pledges is USD. 14.1 million and contribution received is USD. 10.6 million. They include resources for OEWG (USD. 1.2 million). The UK and Japan funds are expected to reduce the funding gap once they are realized.



UNEP accountability on use of resources

- 1. The UN Financial Regulations and Rules ST/SGB/2013/4/Amend.1 and other administrative instructions, policies and procedures.
- 2. Segregation of roles. Through the delegation of Authority, the approval and certification roles are clearly defined.
- 3. Project review Committee approves projects and UNEP Evaluation office (promotes learning and accountability and is a key source of credible, timely and evidence-based information and a critical tool for decision-making).
- 4. Internal oversight body of the UN Office of Internal Oversight Services (OIOS), fulfills oversight responsibilities in respect of resources and staff (internal Audit, Inspection and Evaluation and investigations.
- 5. UN Board of Auditors, established by the General Assembly and serves as external auditors for the United Nations. The mandate of the Board is to make independent and professional audit observations with respect to the efficiency of the financial procedures, the accounting system, the internal financial controls and, in general, the administration and management of the United Nations.
