Key facts

- Controlled vocabularies are control tools used for information indexing (catalogers) and retrieval (users)
- The choice of the controlled vocabulary depends on the context and content.
 - UNBIS is adapted to the UN Secretariat work
 - ✓ AGROVOC (FAO) is adapted to agricultural concepts
 - ✓ Gemet is a compilation of several European and UNEP (Envoc) environmental thesauri
 - Sub-topic vocabularies exist
 - The UNEP Library uses a combination of UNBIS and Gemet to reflect both its membership of the UN Secretariat and its environment focus.
 - Other vocabularies in UNEP include SKOS and Sustainable Development Goal Interface Ontology (SDGIO)
- Vocabularies are linked. Concepts in one vocabulary can be translated/mapped to related concepts in another vocabulary.



Recommendations

- Use controlled vocabularies and discard the use of un-controlled vocabularies
- Use the vocabularies that are most appropriate to your content, as long as they are controlled
- Adopt Poolparty as the UNEP semantic aggregator
- Create a standard subject classification scheme that will enable the categorization of content under main clusters or domains in all main UNEP platforms. These clusters shall be the same in all main platforms and will facilitate the fetching of content across platforms (examples in following slides)



Gemet groupings

administration agriculture air animal husbandry biology building chemistry climate disasters, accidents, risk economics energy environmental policy fishery food, drinking water forestry general

legislation materials military aspects natural areas, landscape, ecosystems natural dynamics noise, vibrations physics pollution radiations research resources social aspects, population soil space tourism trade, services
