Mandate

- The CPR, in its CPR-based review, requested the Secretariat to prepare, in consultation with UNEA Bureau and the CPR, a handbook for delegates, which would serve to familiarize delegates with the work of UNEP, including its governing bodies, inter-sessional work, the work of the Bureau and other pertinent matters.
- The UNEA Delegates Handbook will be published in all six UN languages and available online and possibly printed copies.
- The aim is to have the Handbook published before UNEA-6.
- Handbook is designed to suit every delegate but will be most useful to those attending the UNEA sessions for the first time.





Scope

- Highlights essential information on the work of UNEA and the CPR, including provisions of the Rules of Procedure of UNEA and established practices.
- Provides practical guidance related to delegates' stay in Nairobi.
- Describes services provided by the United Nations Office at Nairobi, including conference services, security, medical, hospitality and common services


