Introduction



The UNEA Monitoring and Reporting Portal is a dedicated platform for **monitoring** and **reporting** of progress in the implementation of UNEA resolutions, decisions and declarations in the context of the Programme of Work



The Portal was developed in response to UNEA resolution 4/22, implementation and follow up of UNEA resolutions

Why is the Portal Important?

Better Implementation and Follow-up

- Use of Portal provides better coordination of implementation and follow-up of resolutions contributing to achievement of the environmental dimension of the SDGs
- It promotes learning identified gaps, challenges and best practice for emulation

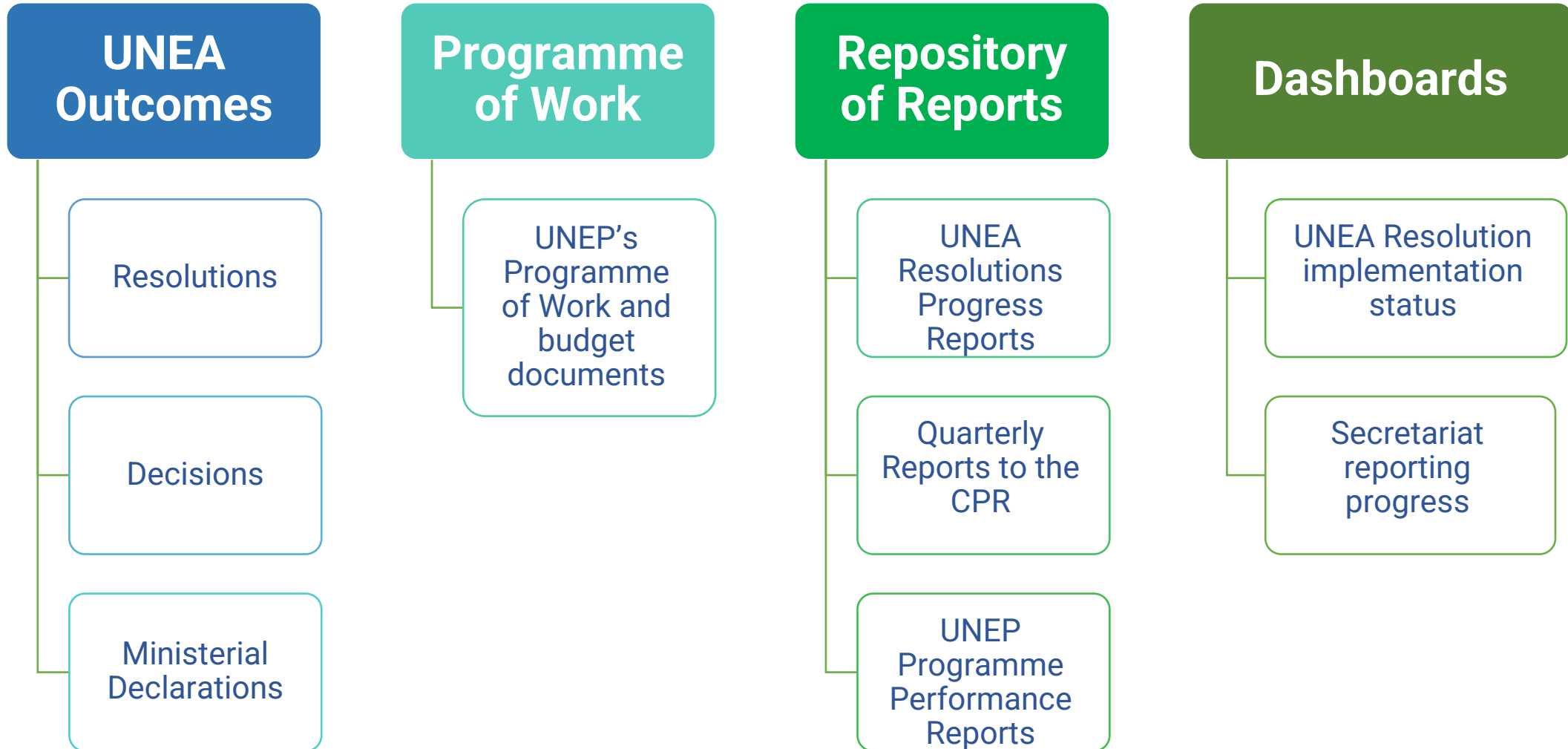
Better Quality UNEA Resolutions and Decisions

- It provides a repository of information on what has already been addressed to help prevent duplication of UNEA resolutions. Lessons and best practices of previous resolution can improve future mandates and processes

Comprehensive View of UNEA Impact

- Secretariat Reporting alone does not give the full picture of impact of UNEA as Resolutions often identify actions for Member States and other actors
- Voluntary reporting by Member States will help fill this picture

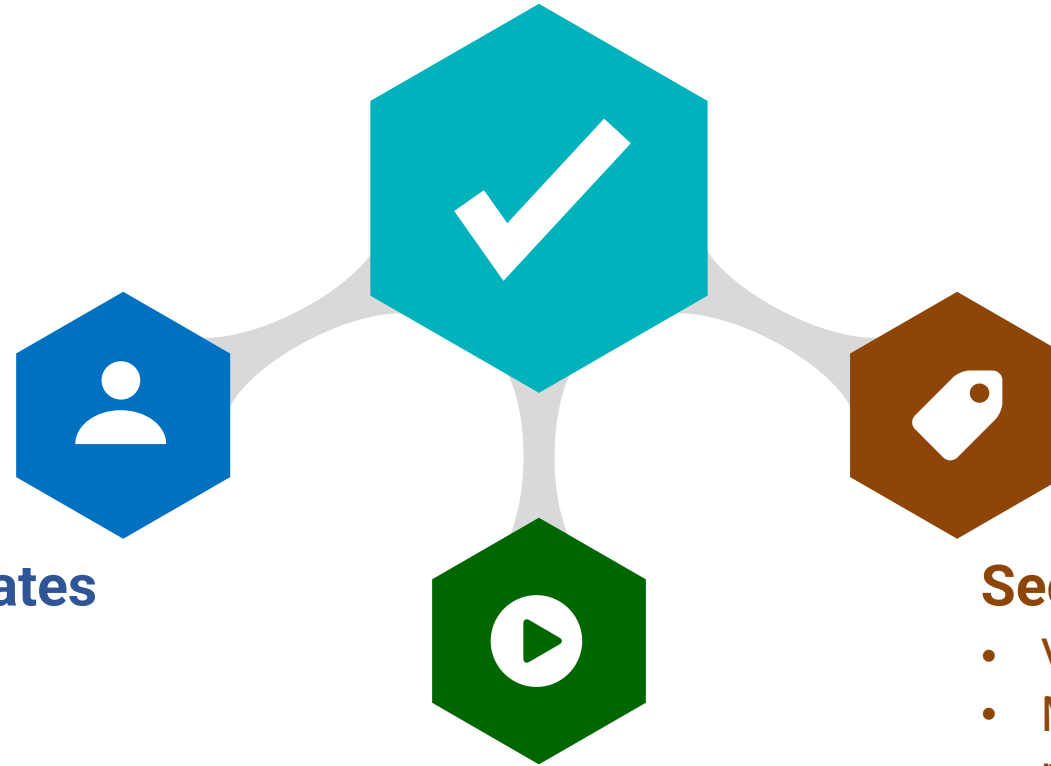

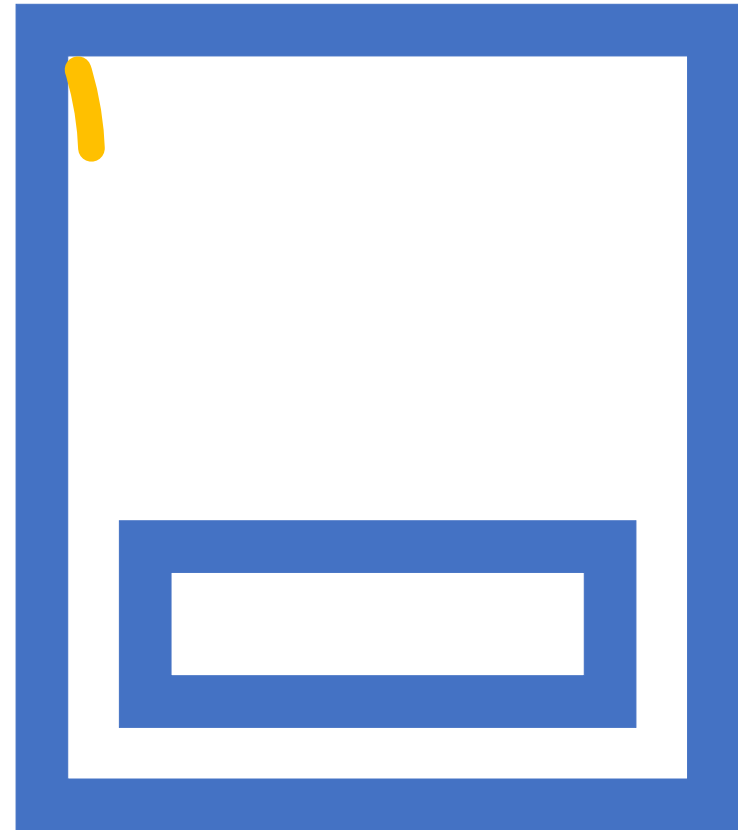

Secretariat Reporting

- Mandatory
- Every six months
- Reporting done by designated Secretariat focal points

Member State Reporting

- Voluntary
- Ad hoc
- Reporting by designated Member State focal points

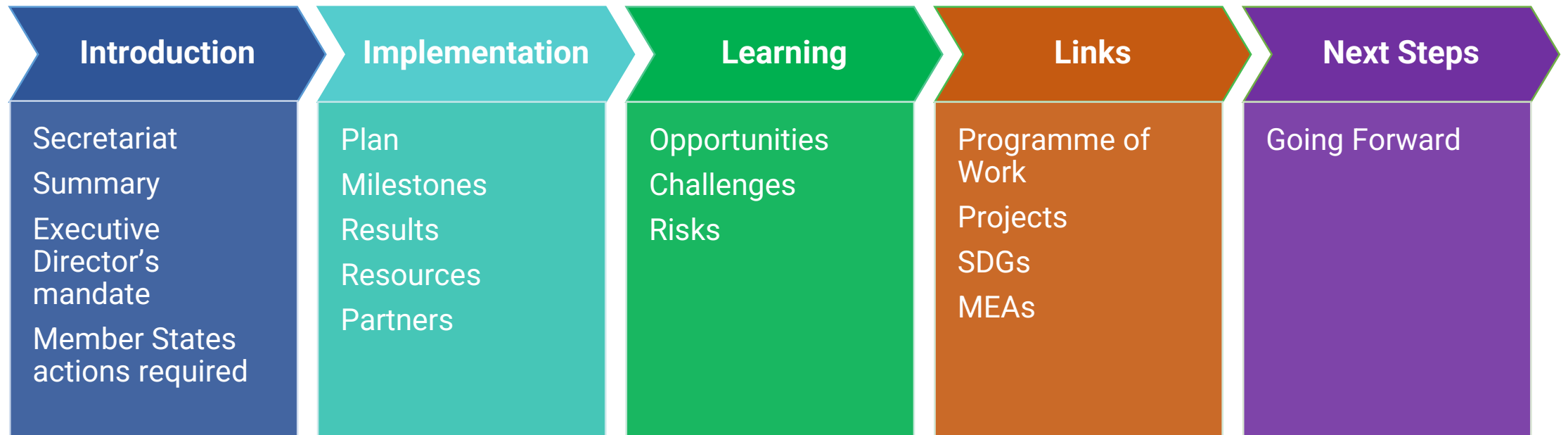
Voluntary Reporting Process

Member States who wish to voluntarily report are requested to designate reporting focal points to ensure proper validation of data using two options:

a) Provide details of designated focal points through a *Note Verbale* to the UNEA Portal team at unea-monitoring-support@un.org with a copy to the Governance Affairs Office at unep-sgb@un.org

b) A designated focal point may also register for reporting directly using the portal's [registration form](#) which requires them to upload a *Note Verbale as proof of designation*
