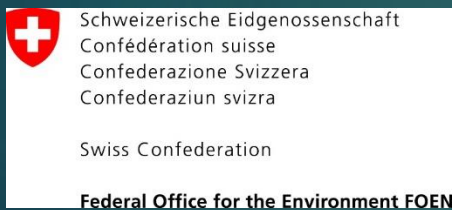

# What is DaRT?

- **DaRT** is the first tool that supports Parties in sharing, organizing and maintaining data, knowledge and information **across biodiversity-related conventions**
  - **DaRT** has been developed by UNEP under the **Environmental Treaties Programme-Realizing synergies for biodiversity** (multi-donor project)
  - **DaRT** project is generously funded by the **European Union**, co-funding by UNEP and Switzerland and closely coordinated with EU projects (**InforMEA, ACP/MEAs**)
- ▶ Supports **synergies in national reporting** towards MEAs and SDGs, leading to improved global stocktake
  - ▶ Contributes to a more effective **implementation and monitoring** of the KM-GBF:
    - ▶ **For Parties:** Supports the alignment of **NBSAPs with the GBF**
    - ▶ **For biodiversity-related conventions:** Support the mapping of strategic plans with the **GBF**



# Opportunities for Parties to MEAs

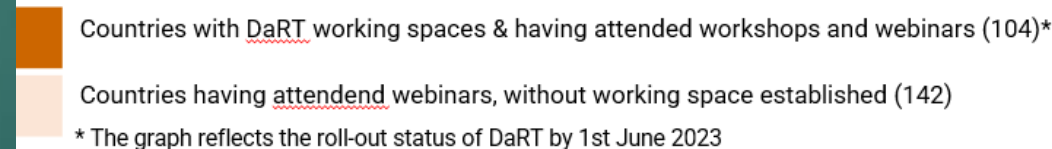
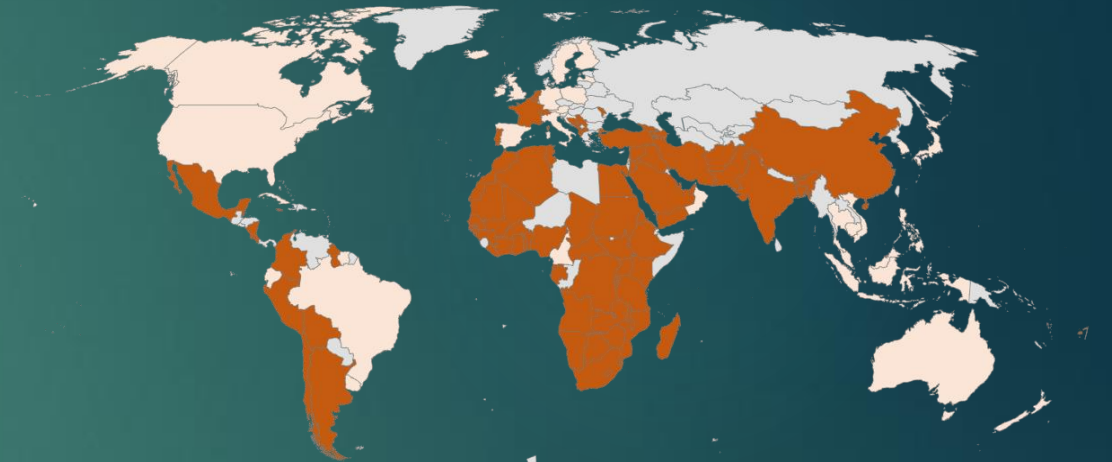


## Opportunities identified by countries using DaRT

1. Visualization of **cross-mappings** among MEA strategic plans and **SDGs**
2. Bring together **MEA focal points**, environmental directorates, development partners, sectoral departments, academic researchers...etc.
3. Consolidation of information and data on the implementation of MEAs in **one single national workspace**
4. Harmonization and **standardization of information**, knowledge, data and reports for all conventions

## DaRT as of June 2023

- National and regional DaRT **workshops** organized for 29 countries
- **Webinars** attended by experts from 101 countries
- DaRT **national working spaces** functional for 104 countries
