UNEA-5 Resolution 12 "Environmental Aspects of Minerals and Metals Management"

The United Nations Environment Assembly at its 5th session adopted a resolution entitled "Environmental Aspects of Minerals and Metals Management" (UNEP/EA.5/Res.12) which focusses on improving the environmental aspects of mining along their full life cycle and requests UNEP, subject to available resources, to:

OP2:

"...convene transparent and inclusive intergovernmental regional consultations, including with relevant international organizations, with regional and multilateral environmental agreements, and with relevant stakeholders acting as observers, to feed into a global intergovernmental meeting, with the aim of developing non-prescriptive proposals to enhance the environmental sustainability of minerals and metals along their full life cycle, in line with the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development."





UNEA-5 Resolution 12 "Environmental Aspects of Minerals and Metals Management"

OP4:

Requests the Executive Director, through the Global Resource Information Database (GRID-Geneva), to **strengthen scientific, technical and policy knowledge with regard to sand**, and to support global policies and action regarding the environmentally sound extraction and use thereof;



OP5:

Also requests the Executive Director, subject to the availability of resources, with the engagement of the secretariats of relevant multilateral environmental agreements, organizations and stakeholders, as appropriate, and bearing in mind the launch of the Global Industry Standard on Tailings Management, to compile a report on knowledge gaps in relation to the environmental aspects of tailings management;

Component 1 (OP2): Intergovernmental Consultations - Process

- National focal points: 113 nominated member State government representatives with relevant expertise.
- Co-chairs: appointed from Pakistan and Switzerland.
- **Background documents**: prepared and published on a dedicated web <u>platform</u>.
- Virtual briefings: 7 webinars held to prepare for and consult on the planned meetings.
- Written submissions: 30 received, from States and observers.

Development of 'non-prescriptive proposals'

- ☐ 24 'NPPs' arising from regional consultations.
- ☐ Global meeting enabled further discussion and streamlining.
- 4 thematic priorities emerged:
 - A global assessment of existing instruments and standards:
 - A global sand observatory;
 - Open-ended / technical working group;
 - Capacity-building, technical assistance, technology transfer;
 - **Enhanced international** cooperation.

Component 2 (OP2 & OP4): Sand and Sustainability



• Sand and Sustainability report: On 26 April 2022, UNEP/GRID-Geneva launched the 'Sand and sustainability: 10 strategic recommendations to avert a crisis'.

 Marine Sand Watch: In September 2023, UNEP/GRID-Geneva, Global Fishing Watch and other partners launched a worldfirst public data platform 'Marine Sand Watch', to track marine dredging activities.



- UNEA Res.5/12 Intergovernmental process: Sand was a specific agenda item at the meetings, which led to a
 non-prescriptive proposal for the establishment of a Global Sand Observatory.
 - > Subject to member States consideration and decision, the observatory would possibly support countries in raising awareness, developing knowledge and taking decisions to improve sustainability of sand extraction and use.





Component 3 (OP2 & OP5): Tailings Management

- **UNEA Res.5/12 Intergovernmental process**: tailings management was a specific agenda item during the intergovernmental consultation meetings. Over 150 comments relating to tailings knowledge gaps were recorded from participants, during robust information exchange.
- Report on knowledge gaps on mine tailings management: Requested under UNEA Res. 5/12 (OP5) and under development.
- Building on past achievements: the report will draw from the oral and written submissions made during the 5/12 intergovernmental process as well as build upon the Global Tailings Review, the Global Industry Standard on Tailings Management, and the Global Tailings Portal, previously initiated by UNEP and partners.
- **Consultations:** Virtual workshops involving the Res. 5/12 national focal points and experts will be undertaken to inform the report development (14 November).
- **UNEA 6:** Report will be made available as an information document for the sixth session of the UN Environment Assembly.
