

NbS Examples Submitted by WWF to the Intergovernmental Consultations on Nature-based Solutions

WWF has been implementing NbS in the Asia Pacific Region especially focusing on coastal communities, mountain ecosystems, delta regions, and urban areas to address climate change challenges, contribute towards sustainable development goals and address biodiversity benefits. We use NbS to address triple challenges – climate crisis, biodiversity crisis, and nature loss.

We are using NbS approaches to address climate impacts in coral ecosystems by undertaking climate vulnerability assessment and identifying appropriate adaptation measures of Nature-based solution approaches in the Coral Triangle Region (Countries include: Indonesia, PNG, Malaysia, Solomon Islands, and Timor-Leste)

We are implementing NbS for climate change adaptation for Pakistan focusing on glacial retreat, and flooding through the program named 'Recharge Pakistan'. Together with the Government of Pakistan, WWF managed to secure GCF Funding of around 77 Million USD for NbS for Climate Change Adaptation.

We are also focusing in the Mekong Delta region and Pacific Island in Fiji on the NbS for climate change adaptation, focusing on flooding, siltation, and coastal communities, including the consultation with indigenous communities and local stakeholders. Mangrove Restoration is one of the key NbS interventions.
